Dear Friends in Christ,

Over time, I see the hand of God in the naming of our parish under the love and protection of the Infant Jesus. Reverence for the Infant Jesus brings about a loving awareness of the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Most Blessed Trinity. "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us." This is a powerful fulfillment of the Lord's name, Emmanuel ("God with us"). As the true faith, we are blessed to have the Real Presence of the Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament. We wanted our annual Forty Hours or Eucharistic Devotion to center around our feast day: the Epiphany. The Epiphany is about recognizing the Lord and adoring Him. That is exactly what we hope to do during the three special days in our parish: January 4-6, 2013. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for love and adoration during these days, on the hour without any stopping. The only time there will not be adoration in the monstrance will be during the Mass. Our Lord wants you to spend time with Him. He thirsts for your love. Give Him your time. Come alone, bring your family, tell your friends, gather with those who serve in your ministry. The question our Lord posed to Peter in the Garden is proposed to us during these upcoming blessed days, "Could you not keep watch with me one hour?" (Matthew 26:40). Please do not reject *His* invitation.

Child Assault Prevention (CAP)

The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. the policy of the diocese is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

CAP 1 teaches attendees to recognize child abuse and neglect and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

CAP 2 is No More Bullies, No More Victims and is a workshop on bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyberbullying is also addressed. Both sessions are 90 minutes.

Adults must attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2. After 5 years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1 again if they prefer.
