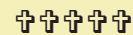

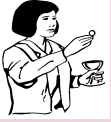

YEAR OF FAITH FACTOID

Who leads the celebration of the Eucharist? (aka Mass)

[CCC 1348]

Actually, Christ himself acts in every celebration of the Eucharist. The bishop, or priest, re-presents Him.

It is the Church's belief that the celebrant (the priest) stands at the altar in persona Christi capitis (Latin = in the person of Christ, the Head). This means that priests do not merely act in Christ's place or at His command; rather, on the basis of their ordination, Christ Himself, as Head of the Church, acts through them.
