For the next three weeks, Father King will be travelling in India with Richard Macdonald on a pilgrimage to Blessed Teresa of Calcutta's tomb, to work with the Missionaries of Charity and to see some of the rich sites in that extraordinary country. We will all look forward to Father's return to share with us the graces that are wrought from this trip. Mother Teresa is a force that continues to inspire men and women to "sate the thirst of Jesus." Father will see things that many of us will never see, but as Mother reminded us, "We all have Calcutta in our lives." The lonely in our homes, neighborhood or work place are Jesus in His distressing disguise. He thirsts for our love...for our attention, not because He is some narcissist, but because the Lord wants to have a loving, reciprocal relationship with each of us. We need to change hearts and stop the killing, not only in our streets, but in the womb! May the Lord guide us to have hearts to love. May Our Lady be with Father King as he prays for us before the relic of a woman to whom it has been said, "We will marvel that we lived in the same time as Mother Teresa and John Paul II!"
