Dear Friends in Christ,

March begins the month dedicated to Saint Joseph. We celebrate his feast day, Saint Joseph, Spouse of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, every year on March 19<sup>th</sup>. This powerful, silent saint is very special since he is a heartbeat away from Jesus. He had the privilege of being married to the most special and beautiful of all women and was called upon by the Most High God to raise the Savior of mankind. Blessed John Paul II said in a Sunday Angelus message in 2002: "According to ancient tradition, Saint Joseph watches over and protects the Church. He is considered the model of perfect Christian life and the patron of a happy death. His patronage extends over the Mystical Body of Christ, over the Christian family and schools, carpenters, fathers, laborers, and all individuals who appeal to his charity and intercession, especially in the hour of death. Joseph, when dying, received the loving ministry of his foster Son, Jesus, and his spouse, the Blessed Virgin Mary, so it is believed that his intercession may well obtain the mercy of God and the grace of a peaceful and holy death." So often, we get caught up in what people say. We have no recorded words of this great saint and yet he is so beloved amongst the faithful. He teaches us that love is not merely a word to be uttered, but must be lived and shown by how we live our lives. How do we love Jesus? Merely on our lips? We should imitate this saint by showing Jesus how much we love Him by leading lives that are pure, holy, prayerful and service oriented. We should work hard for the greater honor and glory of God. We must be loyal and true to our Catholic faith since Saint Joseph watches over the Church with love as it is the Mystical Body of Christ. As the Church we pray for a new successor to Saint Peter; let us entrust our cares to the intercession of Saint Joseph. May his prayers help us to be given a great pope who will shepherd our Church; the Church so loved and protected by the holy Saint Joseph.

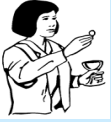

## CAP (Child Assault Prevention)

The policy of the diocese is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

CAP 1 teaches attendees to recognize child abuse and neglect and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

CAP 2 is No More Bullies, No More Victims and is a workshop on bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyberbullying is also addressed. Both sessions are 90 minutes.

Adults must attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1 again if they prefer.
