Dear Friends in Christ,

Pastor 🛴 "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever." (Psalm 23:6). Oh what a beautiful desire to dwell in God's house! I recently had a young person tell me that she "would sleep in church if she could!" She did not mean taking a snooze during a boring homily, but expressed a joy at being in the House of the Lord. I cannot tell you what a beautiful thing for a pastor to hear and from one of our youth! As we examine ourselves this season of Lent, we must wonder if we enjoy being with the Lord in a place set aside for His honor and glory, where the presence of the Lord in the tabernacle warms our very being, statues of Our Lady, Saint Joseph and others along with the smell of incense and candles. The tolling bells call us to worship and the bells ring joyfully at Mass as the Holy Spirit is called upon to change bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ at the voice of the priest, a mere mortal. Is spending time in the Lord's house a burden? What is more important in our everyday lives? Do we really think that half of what we run around doing is more important than loving the God who causes every breath and heartbeat?
