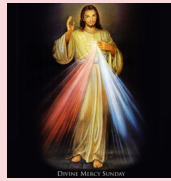

Dear Friends in Christ,

Once again, Happy Easter! Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! We continue as disciples to bathe in the joy and love of the Resurrection of Our Savior. The Church wisely continues to celebrate this core mystery of our faith until Pentecost on May 19th. Today is a special day to remind us of the merciful and forgiving love of Jesus to whom we are to give all our trust. Please see information in the bulletin about our parish hosting a special celebration on this Sunday afternoon. We share this gathering with Incarnation Parish and Holy Angels Parish. This Lent was filled with so many opportunities to receive graces. Our Soup and Scripture nights were a huge success as we heard fellow parishioners witness to their conversion and growth in the Lord. Parishioners made wonderful, creative meatless soups that allowed us to share God's goodness together. Our Stations of the Cross saw varied ways of bringing the Via Dolorosa to life: Alliance of the Two Hearts, the King's Men, the Youth Group, and the Franciscan Mystery Players; young people performed the living stations spearheaded by our Religious Education Department as well as living stations offered by Saint Margaret's School during Holy Week. *Sweet Inspirations* performed a concert that was a beautiful, prayerful experience. Our Triduum was special this year: Father Felipe washed the feet of twelve men from our parish on Holy Thursday; on Good Friday, Father King showed us the need to carry and adore the Cross and I had the honor to baptize two new Catholics and confirm all five into full communion with the Holy Catholic Church. Our celebrations at both of our churches were enhanced by the beautiful decorating of our Altar and Rosary Society; the lovely singing of our choirs and cantors; our lectors, altar servers and all called to serve. Once again, our Saint Vincent de Paul Society gave out an unbelievable amount of food, not only Easter baskets, but throughout the season. This is due to your generosity. In the midst of everything, Bishop Sullivan visited us for a House of Charity gathering, eating dinner in our rectory and he returned to parish on March 16th to confirm our young people. On top of it all we received a new pope in Francis. I express my gratitude to my brother priests, Fathers King and Felipe for all their ministry as we served the sick and heard an unbelievable amount of confessions. Yes, I believe that we have much to be grateful for in our parish this Easter. May the Infant Jesus smile on us all.

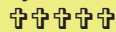

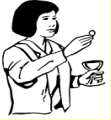
