Dear Friends in Christ,

Last year, we heard about threats to religious liberty and the United States Bishops responded by calling for a *Fortnight for Freedom*. Have the threats gone away? Hardly! They are being ratcheted up. The HHS mandate is as dangerous to religious liberty as ever. The bishops have called for a second two week period of prayer, fasting, educating and reacting to challenges to our religious liberty. We may think that it is much ado about nothing, but as we hear on the news about all types of spying on personal liberties, we should not be naïve to think that our religious liberties are not in danger. A few examples are that the HHS mandate would force religious institutions as of August 1, 2013 to facilitate and fund contraception, sterilization and abortion inducing drugs; in some states Catholic Charities are being pressured to close if they do not place babies for adoption with same sex couples or couples who are merely living together outside of marriage. New York City is adopting a policy that would not allow a church to rent public school buildings although other questionable groups are free to do so. There is mounting pressure to have churches provide different ceremonies of marriage outside of traditional Christian teaching. The Church merely wants to retain the right as Americans to practice her faith without interference from the state which would cause devout Catholics to violate their religious conscience. We must not continue to keep our heads in the sand and simply say, “What are you going to do?” Jesus says, “This kind can only come out by prayer and fasting.” (Mark 9:29). There is an evil wind ripping through our society. Hold on to Christ, embrace the Truth, find out what is going on and pray to support those fighting evils in court. The *Fortnight for Freedom* begins on June 21st and concluded on July 4th. Commit to attending Mass during the week as much as possible, make visits to the Most Blessed Sacrament, pray the Holy Rosary, fast from desserts or abstain from meat. Pray a favorites novena. Check out the United States Catholic Conference of Catholic Bishops’ website: www.usccb.org. It is very educational on many issues. Let us do something! Helen Keller said, “Science may have found a cure for most evils; but it has found no remedy for the worst of them all -- the apathy of human beings.”
