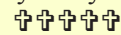

Dear Friends in Christ,

I recently spoke about the plight of Christians suffering in the Holy Land. As events unfold in Egypt and Syria, we must intensify our prayers for our brothers and sisters who are being persecuted for their faith. We have a religious community in our diocese who are very close to the Egyptian situation. The Franciscan Missionary Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary who reside in Glassboro and are assigned to Saint Michael Regional School in Clayton; Our Lady of Peace in Williamstown and Our Lady of Hope, Blackwood were founded in Egypt and have a number of houses there. The sisters and their schools have been attacked and looted. They are right in the main area of Cairo. We must support our friends in prayer. Father Boulos Fahmy, the pastor of a Catholic church said, "I am terrified and unable to focus...I am expecting an attack on my church any time now." Too often, we take our Catholic faith for granted while these brave souls continue to proclaim their love for the true faith despite being in the minority and for being the scapegoat of misplaced hatred. We need to prayerfully watch this situation very closely. May Our Lady, who appeared in Zeitoun, Egypt watch over the Christian presence in that ancient land including Egypt, Syria, Israel, Lebanon, Iraq and Iran.

Filling the Darkness With Light

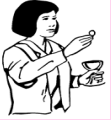

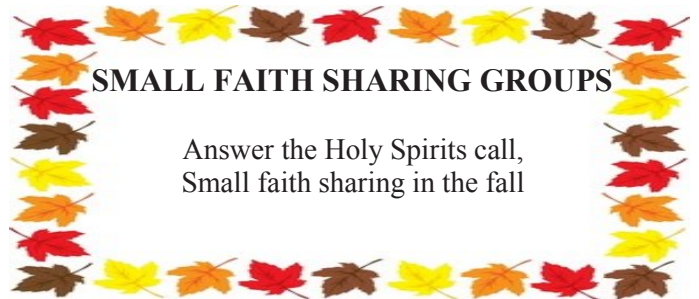
