

Dear Friends in Christ,

On July 5, 2013, Pope Francis launched his first encyclical which was the completion of a work written by the Pope Emeritus, Benedict XVI. It is entitled, *Lumen Fidei* or *Light of Faith*. I hope that everyone will take the time to read this encyclical as there it addresses the crisis of faith in our society today. Scandals, corruption, evil acts and the lack of civility can be traced to a lack of faith in God. Why be good if there is no God? Get all that you can out of this life: "Eat, drink and be merry for tomorrow we die. A Catholic News Service article gives some of the highlights of this work. "The opposite of faith is idolatry, according to which man worships the 'multiplicity of his desires.'" That is a powerful statement worthy of our meditation. The Holy Father says, "Salvation is impossible through our own good works but requires faith, as acknowledgement of the 'primacy of God's gift.'" Merely being good and doing good are not going to save us. He also says, "Faith is not individualistic but by its very nature takes place within the communion of the church" and "The unity and continuity of the faith are ensured by the apostolic succession, hence the pope and the bishops in communion with him stand as its authoritative teachers." It is evident that the Holy Father is reminding us of the need for the Church and the need to avoid the creation of a religion of our own making. A beautiful statement is that "the fullness of faith is transmitted above all through the sacraments, which 'communicate an incarnate memory, linked to the times and places of our lives, linked to all our senses; in them the whole person is engaged as a member of a living subject and part of a network of communitarian relationships'" and "faith offers access to truth through love, since love is a 'form of shared knowledge, vision through the eyes of another and a shared vision of all that exists.' Certainly, there is so much more to this work and it contains the mind of both Pope Emeritus Benedict and Pope Francis. May our summer reading be more than a novel on the beach, but rather a work that will give food to the soul.




