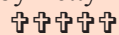

We each took turns offering the Holy Mass at different holy sites and by Divine Providence, I was the main celebrant for the Mass at the Church of the Nativity where Jesus was born in Bethlehem! I offered Mass in Saint Jerome's chapel which is the cave where the great Saint Jerome translated the Holy Scriptures. Know that I remembered all our parishioners of the Infant Jesus Parish at that Mass. Being offered the time to pray and meditate it became clearer how blessed I am to be your servant at this parish. We are a graced parish where there are many people who are serious about their relationship with Christ. While it is a blessing to go to Israel, we must find God in our immediate situation. 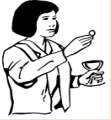


## DEVOTED
