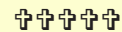

Dear Friends in Christ,



As you read this letter, I will be on my annual retreat which is mandated by the Church. It is a great joy and gift to be able to get away to a quiet place for a week of prayer, reflection and reorganizing one's interior life. You may say, "Boy, I wish that I could go away on a retreat!" I wish you could also. Our lives are so full, complicated and noisy, that it is very difficult to find the silence to speak to God, to see where one is going and where one has fallen along the way. Mother Teresa said, "In the silence of the heart God speaks. If you face God in prayer and silence, God will speak to you. Then you will know that you are nothing. It is only when you realize your nothingness, your emptiness, that God can fill you with Himself. Souls of prayer are souls of great silence." I will be away at a Trappist monastery where one is to remain silent in order to converse with God alone. There is much land to walk, an abbey and chapel to pray before the Blessed Sacrament and a humble room to enclose oneself into union with the Lord. This silence, which is so beneficial, is something we should strive for in our churches and chapel. Too often, people are praying an appropriate act of thanksgiving after Mass and their prayer is interrupted by people standing in the aisle chatting, laughing and most likely not having a spiritual discussion. Lest one think I am a Grinch, I do want people to enjoy each other. That is Christian love. But, it is also important that we have a due reverence for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and have respect for our brothers and sisters who long for a silent moment with the Lord. Step outside and rejoice! Nicholas Sparks in his work, *The Notebook*, says, "Silence is pure and holy. It draws people together because only those who are comfortable with each other can sit without speaking." In my silence this week, be assured of my prayers for you and your intentions.
