Dear Friends in Christ,

On my way returning from my annual retreat, I traveled with two priests to Mount Equinox in Vermont. It is there where the Carthusian monks in America dwell. They are the strictest of all the monastic orders, being hermits who live in a community setting. They are silent and wake at all hours to pray for we who abandon the love that God extends to the world. It has been said of these monks, "The order never reformed, because it never deformed." We were not able to enter the monastery as no one is able to do so, but we traveled up to Mount Equinox to see the visitors' center which was built to give some insight into the Carthusian life. Down on the ground, we were told that it was not a good day to go up the mountain. We expressed this was the only day we could do so. They allowed us to travel up the five mile trip. It became foggier, windier with a driving rain; it was really quite dangerous. We had just arrived at the center when they radioed from the ground, "Get the three priests off the mountain, the winds are already at seventy-five miles per hour." I have never been in such wild conditions; who knows how strong the winds gusted. The guide followed our car down the mountain as the three of us prayed the Holy Rosary. It was an experience. Being so close to the holy monks meant so much and this short journey caused me to meditate on our attempts to ascend the spiritual mountain. The spiritual life can be treacherous. This world will throw so much at us to try to frighten us, to deter us from reaching our goal and to attempt to hold us from the peace that God alone can give. Every one of us must ascend the mountain to find God. Not literally of course, but the mountain that is our heart. May we all seek the Lord every day and stop giving into the buffeting winds of the world. The lies are so loud! They are so evil! The strength of the Holy Spirit is the rushing wind that will give us the grace to persevere. May Our Lady of the Holy Rosary obtain graces for you and your family.

A Place at the Table

*1 in 6 Americans - 50 million - are food insecure; 1 in 4 children - 17 million - are food insecure (2010)
*85% of those families that are food insecure they have at least one working adult in the household.
* Food stamp eligibility is based on total household income. To qualify, of 4 income for a family of 4 cannot exceed \$29,000 per year: the average food stamp benefit is under \$5 a day.
