Dear Friends in Christ,

On the weekend of September 7-8th, you will hear at Mass about a great spiritual opportunity within Infant Jesus Parish. As you should have heard, we will be starting Small Faith Sharing Groups in our parish. You will be invited to sign up for a group which will involve getting together with fellow Catholics and through prayer and discussion you may grow even deeper in your relationship with the Lord. The times in which we live are going to continue to challenge one's faith more than we could ever imagine and being connected to fellow Catholics on a personal level is a beautiful way to obtain the strength that is necessary to live the Gospel in a brave and uncompromising way. In a General Audience on May 15, 2013, Pope Francis spoke on the need to pray and especially to invoke the Holy Spirit, "This is a prayer that we need to say every day: 'Holy Spirit, make my heart open to God's Word so that my heart might be open to good, so that my heart might be open to God's beauty every day.' Let me ask you: how many of you pray to the Holy Spirit every day? It will be few of you, but we must satisfy this desire for Jesus and pray every day to the Holy Spirit that He might open our hearts to Jesus." Yes, if not closed, at the very least our souls are clouded from hearing God, from seeing His love. We think we have too much to do...are we too busy to deepen our relationship with our loving God? Please be open to the message you will hear; perhaps the Spirit will be touching your heart. Have a blessed Labor Day!

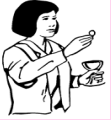
