Dear Friends in Christ,



One of the pillars in the gymnasium at Saint Margaret School was discovered to have old termite damage at the base. There are not any of those vile creatures active anymore, but they did their damage a long time ago. The rotten wood was discovered when the cove molding was removed for replacement at the base of the pillar on the left, facing the stage. Since safety is our main concern, we employed a company from Hackensack, NJ to shore it up until the damaged section can be replaced. The present scaffolding removes about a quarter of usage for the gym and it precludes any athletic events until the scaffolding is removed. We are guessing that it will take approximately a month for the completion of the project. I was meditating on how our souls are like those pillars. Sin is like termites, eating at the very base of who we are. We hide our sins, we ignore our sins and on the outside everything looks okay. It is not until we open up and see what is really going on underneath that we discover damage that may be quite old. Confession allows us to open up what is hidden and to allow God to rebuild that which has been eaten away by evil. Do not keep the damage locked away which could cause the whole structure to come down in your soul. Go to confession, reveal the hidden damage and then the Master Carpenter, Jesus, through His priest, will begin to rebuild the damage! As Jesus tells us, "Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free." (John 8:32).
