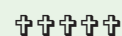
COME LET US ADORE HIM

Dear Friends in Christ,




On September 27, 2015, we will be welcoming a new group of friends to Infant Jesus Parish. I was asked if we could accommodate members of the Syro-Malybar Rite to offer Mass on Sundays. This Mass will be at 4:00 PM at Saint John Vianney Church every Sunday. Of course, we might wonder how this is possible when we have a 4:00 PM Mass at Saint Margaret Church. This will remain in place. According to *Wikipedia*, "The Syro-Malabar Catholic Church or Church of Malabar Syrians is a Major Archiepiscopal Church in full communion with the Catholic Church. The Church is headed by the Major Archbishop of Ernakulam-Angamaly, Mar George Alencherry. The members of the Church are known as Mar Thoma Nasranis or Syrian Catholics. It is the largest of the Nasrani denominations with around 4.6 million believers and traces its origins to the evangelistic activity of Thomas the Apostle in the 1st century. The Syro-Malabar Church follows the East Syrian Rite liturgy, traditionally attributed to saints Addai and Mari, which dates back to 3rd century Edessa. It is one of the twenty-three sui iuris Eastern Catholic Churches in the Catholic communion. It is the second largest Eastern Catholic Church, the largest being the Ukrainian Catholic Church. It is one of the two Eastern Catholic Churches from India, the other being the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church which follows the West Syrian Rite liturgy. It is believed that St. Thomas the Apostle landed at Kodungalloor in 52 A. D. and established Christian communities in different parts of India and died at Mylapur in 72 A. D." Certainly, anyone may attend this Mass as it is Catholic, but realize it is not in English. This ancient rite is very beautiful. We welcome this little group to Infant Jesus Parish!

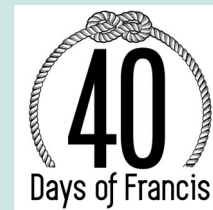

40 Days of Francis: Day 6

Pope Francis quote of the week: I would like to ask you all to see a ray of hope as well in the eyes and hearts of refugees and of those who have been forcibly displaced.... I admire the courage of those who hope to be able gradually to resume a normal life, waiting for joy and love to return to brighten their existence. We can and must all nourish this hope!"

Knot of the week: Each year more than 100 refugees leave violence and persecution in their home countries and build new lives in the Diocese of Camden.

With just one week left until the arrival of Pope Francis in Philadelphia this weekend, we are almost finished our 40 Day period of preparation. We remember immigrants and especially refugees this week, who flee violence and must start anew in the Diocese of Camden. This week also begins the World Meeting of Families congress in Philadelphia. Thousands of families from around the world, and several from our parishes and Diocese, will attend this historic gathering of faith.
