

### MERRY CHRISTMAS TO ALL

On Christmas Day, traditionally we greet each other by saying "Merry Christmas" with a smile and joy on our faces. It is so true that Christmas Season stirs up in our hearts the spirits of joy and peace which enable us to be more open for loving, caring, and forgiving. The word "Christmas" comes



from two words put together: Christ and Mass. The word "Mass" is also from the Latin word "Missio" which means "sending forth"; therefore Christmas means "Christ-being-sent". Christ was sent to each one of us personally, with His unconditional love and infinite mercy, He became like us in everything except sin in order to redeem us. He began to redeem us right in the womb of Mary; therefore Christmas is not only about the Birth of our Savior; but it is also the birth of our salvation as well. He wanted to enter into our hearts in order to heal us, to redeem us and to give us joy and peace not only once a year at Christmas; but also at His "weekly Sunday Mass" as well. The truth is that we need salvation, we need Jesus to lead us in this earthly journey, and we need to keep the joyful spirit of Christmas continuing to live in our hearts. For this reason, let us come and adore the Emmanuel in the "Christ-Mass" throughout this coming New Year. May the Birth of the Infant Jesus bring peace and joy to your hearts and your families! - Fr. 
