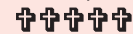

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus sent his disciples in pairs to towns and villages and gave them the authority over unclean spirits: "The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed many with oil who were sick and cured them". Their mission was to heal body and soul.



The same kind of mission was also entrusted to each one of us at our Baptism and constantly repeated at the sending forth at the end of the Mass: "Go in peace and glorify the Lord by your life". Today more than ever, "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few". Jesus truly needs our feet to go out to the "field" to be Christ-like to others. He needs our hands to reach out to those in need of our "bread" and charity, those in need of our patience, understanding, and forgiveness. Foremost, He needs our hearts to heal the hurt and the broken.

Indeed, Jesus needs laborers who are willing to work for his vineyard, who would bring comfort and consolation to the grieving and hope to the hopeless. The "harvest is abundant." The needy, the despairing, the suffering are "abundant" around us but "the laborers are few". Jesus needs us as laborers for his kingdom. He needs husbands and wives to heal each other's "infidelity" which separates them apart. Jesus needs parents and children to heal the "gap" between them due to misunderstandings, unforgiveness, or intolerance. Jesus needs brothers and sisters to heal the "conflict" among them due to disagreements, unforgiveness, hatred, or selfishness.

Let us find ways to heal and reconcile with each other before we come to offer sacrifice at the altar. Let each one of us try to fulfill our earthly mission entrusted to us so that our hearts will be rejoicing "because your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10: 20). - Fr. Joe Pham

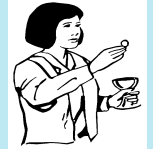

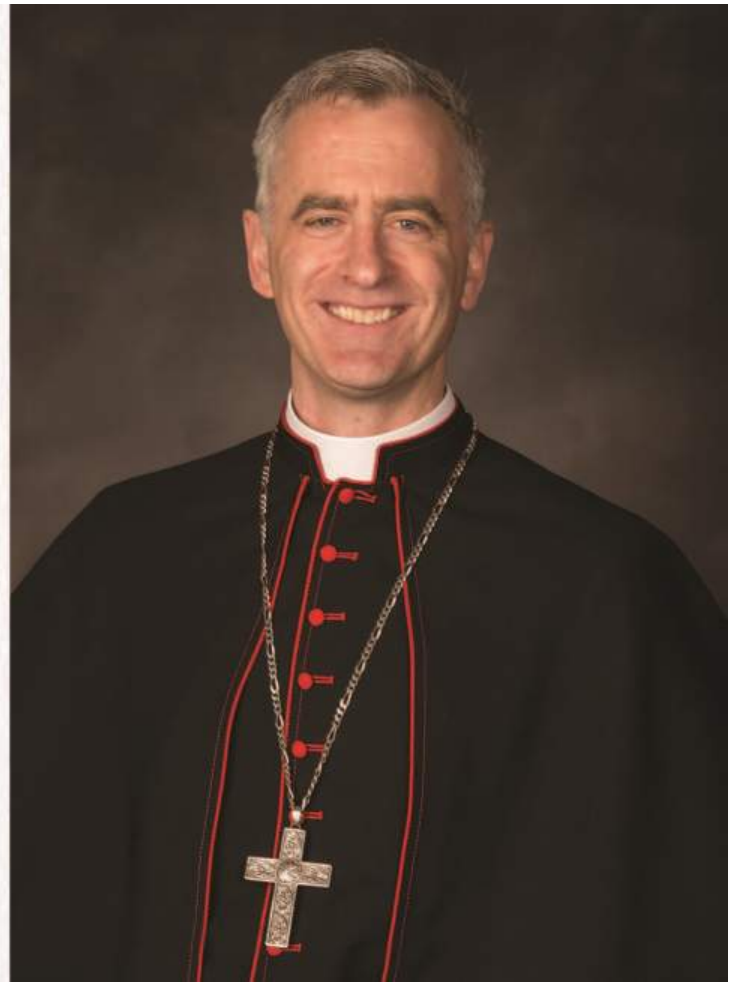
