Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel today is about the miracle of the multiplication of the five loaves and two fish. As a compassionate and loving Jesus, he did not only care for the salvation of the people's souls; but he also cared for their "daily bread" as well.



The Gospel tells us that the people left their homes, towns and villages to go in search of Jesus in a deserted place. When seeing the people coming from afar, Jesus was moved by their spiritual and physical hungers. In order to feed this large crowd, Jesus asked for the boy's charity by sacrificing his five loaves and two fish. Remember, Jesus could have created more than enough bread and fish to feed the thousands of people there without taking the "five loaves and two fish" from the boy; however he wanted to teach us a lesson of love and charity: Where there is love there would be miracle, where there is charity there would be plenty. By the sacrifice of the boy, thousands of people were fed, the impossible became possible.

Looking into the future of our parish, hundreds of thousands of our future generations of Catholics at Infant Jesus Parish also need to be fed. 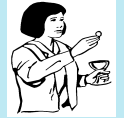
