This Thursday August 15th, the whole Church will joyfully celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mary's body and soul assumed into heaven. 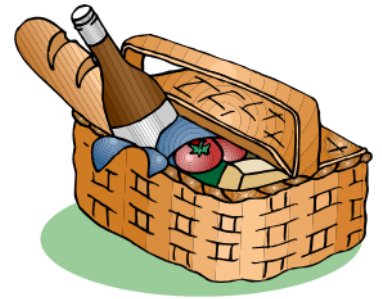
