Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As our nation is observing Labor Day this weekend, we, as Christians, should celebrate it not just as a civil event but also a religious significance as well. From the beginning of creation, God intended to create a perfect world with everything in it including humanity; however human beings misused the God-given power of free will therefore sin entered the world and human labor was one of the consequences of this original sin:



“Because of what you have done, the ground will be under a curse. You will have to work hard all your life to make it produce enough food for you”. (Gen 3:17).

However, thanks be to God for his unconditional love and infinite mercy, he sent his only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem humanity and to reconcile all creation to himself. By this virtual act of redemption of his Son, God transformed the “curse” of human labor into “blessing”. For this reason, our labor now has a redemptive meaning which means our daily labor is a pro-recreation with God, to make this fallen world a better place everyday.

We should learn from Jesus Christ’s work in the economy of salvation which is both human and divine. 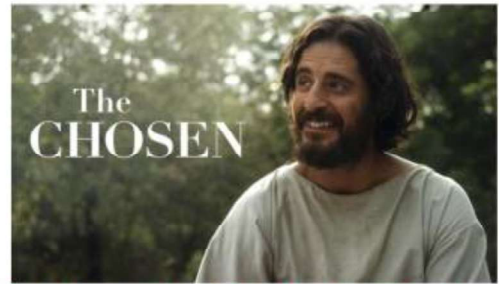

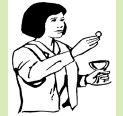
