Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Second Reading is warning us of this "fatal deception" which would either help us to "gain" eternal life or to lose it: "Your wealth has rotted away, your clothes have become moth-eaten, your gold and silver have corroded, and that corrosion will be a testimony against you".



Whatever we own in this world, remember, it is a God-given blessing. Created things are entrusted to us, we do not own them; they belong to our Creator. Each one of us has been entrusted with a certain "amount" for a certain period of time. At the end of this earthly journey, we must make a "report" to our Creator of how we used his blessings on earth. Jesus did not condemn the rich or those who try to work for material things in this world. Rather he condemns those who seek material things as an end of life, those who spend their entire lives "working" for this sole purpose, which then reduces them to merely "material".

As wise stewards of God's creation, we should use our God-given blessings to help us "gain" eternal life and happiness after our stewardship has been taken away. The way to do this is: "I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings". (Luke 16:9).
