

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

This Friday and Saturday, November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, the whole Church will celebrate the glory of All Saints and commemorate All Souls, those who are still in the stage of purification in purgatory. The reason our Church celebrates All Saints and commemorates All Souls is because our religion is a "communion religion".

We are the living. Our lives neither disconnect from the Saints in heaven nor from the dead. We are constantly living in union with the Saints in heaven who constantly intercede for us and for the Holy Souls in purgatory. We, the living, are also in communion with all souls who passed away. 


