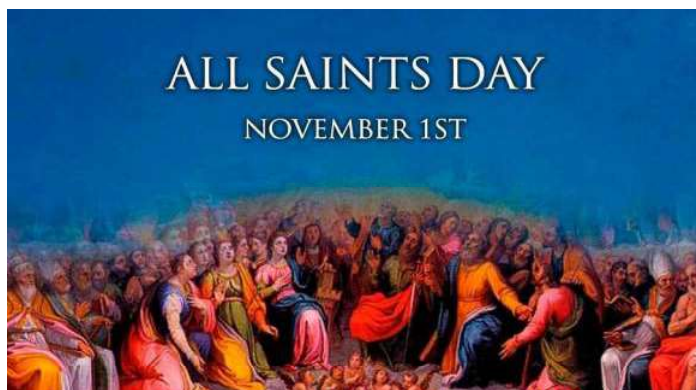

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Friday and Saturday, November 1st and 2nd, the whole Church will celebrate the glory of All Saints and commemorate All Souls, those who are still in the stage of purification in purgatory. The reason our Church celebrates All Saints and commemorates All Souls is because our religion is a “communion religion”.

We are the living. Our lives neither disconnect from the Saints in heaven nor from the dead. We are constantly living in union with the Saints in heaven who constantly intercede for us and for the Holy Souls in purgatory. We, the living, are also in communion with all souls who passed away. As the Saints pray for us, we, the living, in turn, should pray for the dead as well. Only the Saints and we, the living, can pray for the living and the dead. Whereas the dead cannot pray for anyone or for themselves. Therefore, through prayers and acts of charity, the Saints, the living and the dead are intimately in communion with each other in which they can share the merits of charitable work, prayers and penance for the sake of others’ salvation.

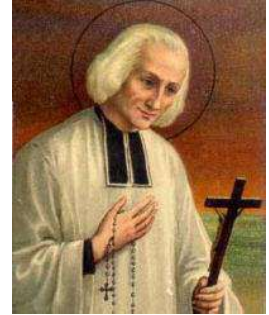
