Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today’s Gospel reminds us of the two essential commandments of our religion which sum up all the “laws and prophets”:

“Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your souls, with all your minds, and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself”.

We know these two commandments by heart, but we often just keep the first one and neglect the other. We have no problem loving God every day with our whole being, but we struggle to love others as ourselves. The reason we have no difficulty loving God is because we can “use” him. We can get “something” from him which no human being is able to give or do for us. We cannot love everyone as ourselves since some of our “neighbors” do not give us anything, they offer no benefits to us. In fact, they sometimes hurt us or cause us troubles. This kind of love is called “conditional love”, the love that expects a return. However, if we want to live and to love this way with this type of love in our lives, then we should not expect God to love us unconditionally. Therefore, when we say: “Jesus, I love you with my whole being”, we must prove it by living out the commandment of “love your neighbor as yourself” as well.

Remember, after the resurrection, the Risen Christ encountered St. Peter with this three-fold question: “Peter, do you love me more than these?” And St. Peter three times responded: “Jesus, you know that I love you”. Then, three times Jesus commanded Peter: “Take care of my lambs and feed my sheep”. This is exactly what Jesus expects us to do to prove our love for him by taking care of his people, feeding his people, and loving his “neighbors”. For this is the only way to prove that “you truly love me and not use me”. -- Fr. Joe Pham

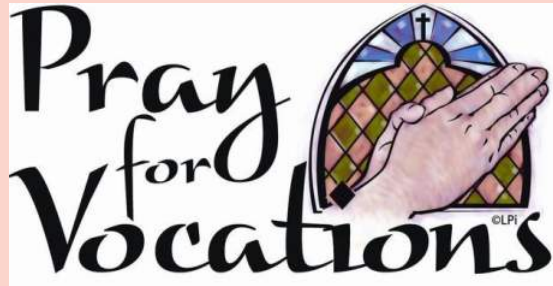

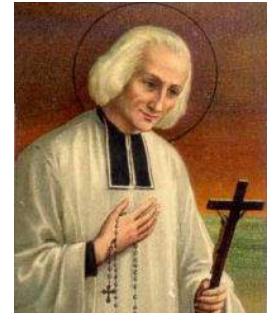
