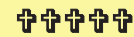

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



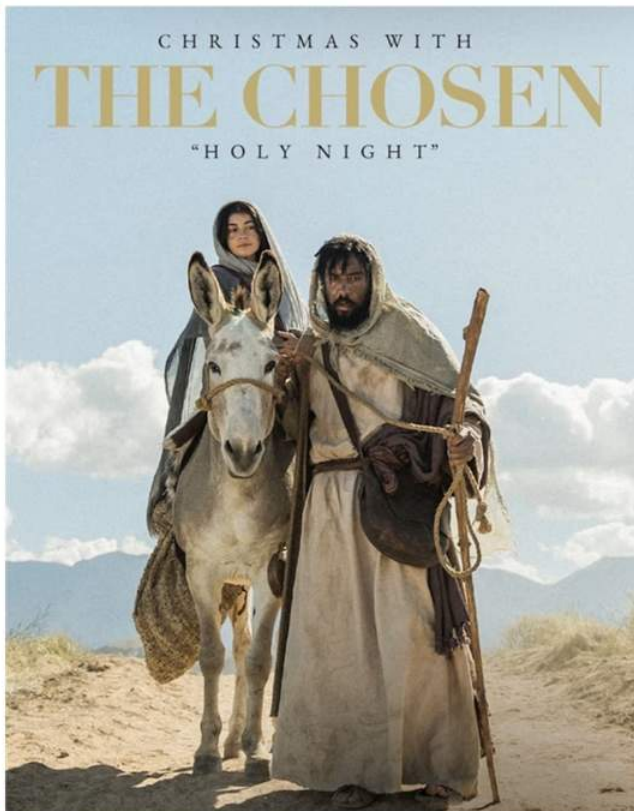
This weekend we are entering the Season of Advent which means the Season of Hope. During the year, the Church sets apart two Seasons: Advent and Lent, in which she tries to impose on the faithful a spirit of penance. For the Advent Season, it embraces four Sundays before the Nativity of the Lord Jesus. The spirit of the Church during this time is symbolized by the violet vestment, it is a sign of penance and a call to conversion in preparation of the Lord's Nativity.
