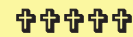

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Monday December 9, the Church of America, will joyfully celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother. God had chosen her from the very beginning to be His first disciple and Mother of His Incarnate Son Jesus Christ.

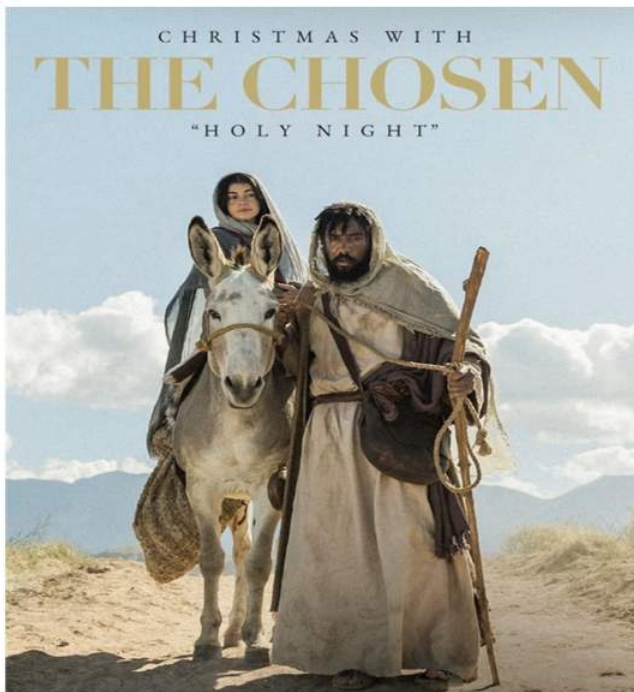


From the moment of her conception, God sanctified her, freed her from the stain of the original sin, so that His Son Jesus Christ would have an immaculate dwelling place in the womb of Mary. The Immaculate Conception of Mary is not something alienated to human nature; but rather, from the beginning, God created humanity in the state of holiness, free from the stain of sin. Mary was chosen and was brought back to that original state of human nature intended by God. God the Father would never have allowed His Son to be born in a womb contracted of any stain of sin. Likewise, God the Son, would never have allowed His Mother, the one who bore Him in her womb, undergo death which was the consequence of the original sin.

The reason for Mary to be chosen as the Mother of God's Son is because she was the best of the best among women. God could not find anyone, except Mary, who completely submitted her will to His divine will. When Mary said: "Let it be done to me according to your words", she surrendered her whole being to God's will, she was ready to accept all the consequences entailed.

As children of Mary, we need to learn from Mary, our Mother, her model of faith and discipleship. We should remind ourselves everyday the prayer of Mary: "Let it be done to me according to your will". Her Son, Jesus, also learned this prayer and prayed in the garden of agony: "Father, not my will; but your will be done".

During this Advent, the Season of Hope, let us surrender whatever it is in our lives to God's providential care and be submissive to His divine will. Remember, God's will is always and must be good for our salvation whether we like it or not. - Fr. Joe Pham
