Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus commanded Peter: "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." In responding to Jesus' command, Peter replied: "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets."

We should learn from St. Peter's obedience and submission to Jesus' command today since, in our daily lives, so many times we have felt the same thing as Peter did. Jesus commands us to "love your enemies, pray for them, forgive them seventy times seven times, etc." However, we often respond: "Jesus I have worked very hard to love, to pray, and to forgive my enemies; but it didn't work since I just could not forget the bad things they did to me and/or to my loved ones. I have been forgiving them over and over again; but they did not change instead, they took advantage of that to hurt me more and more." Jesus also teaches us to keep praying always: "Ask, it will be given, knock the door will be open, seek it will be found, etc." But we often say: "Yes, Jesus I have been praying for days, months, and years now, but I have received nothing."

Hopefully, today when hearing Jesus' command, we will reply to Jesus: "Jesus but at your command, I will do it again until "my nets would be full of fish", until my prayers are answered, my enemies' hearts changed, healing and reconciliation happens. Strengthen me Jesus, give me courage and patience to persevere more in my faith and my prayer life. Open my ears and heart to your voice of command and help us to put your commands into action so miracles may happen in my life and in the lives of my loved ones.
