son who strikes you on one cheek, offer the other one as well, and from the person who takes your cloak, do not withhold even your tunic".


"An eye for an eye" is a cycle of revenge, retaliation. It is a cycle of evil which was defeated by the sacrificial death of our Redeemer, Jesus Christ, on the cross. Imagine if Jesus applied this "principle" to all of us, then no one could escape eternal damnation.


