Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Lent is a penitential season which reminds us of who we are and who God is. On Ash Wednesday, the Church uses the symbol of ashes to signify that we are dust and unto dust we shall return. This is a true statement which is not only true to those who believe in Christ; but it is also true even to atheists. However, our faith tells us that our finite bodies will be raised up on the last day by our Lord Jesus Christ who conquered our human mortality by his death on the cross and his resurrection.

As in today's Gospel Jesus said: "One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God". He meant that we must live our lives in accordance with His Word in order to inherit eternal life and eternal happiness. Ironically, we know that, deep down in our hearts, we want to do and to live God's words in our lives; but very often we fail to do it. As St. Paul put it: "For I do not do what I want to do, but I do what I hate." (Romans 7:15). This is the nature of our human weakness. It is the constant struggle within our hearts, and the battle will never be conquered without the way of the cross.

As Jesus overcame temptations by entering the desert to fast and pray, so we too must fast and pray in order to overcome our weaknesses and temptations. However, perhaps instead of fasting from food, we should fast from wasting our time on social media, from gossiping, or from unnecessary social gatherings. Instead of praying more by our mouths and minds, we should pray more by our hands which means doing more charitable work and patiently helping those who are in need both physically and mentally during these holy forty days.
