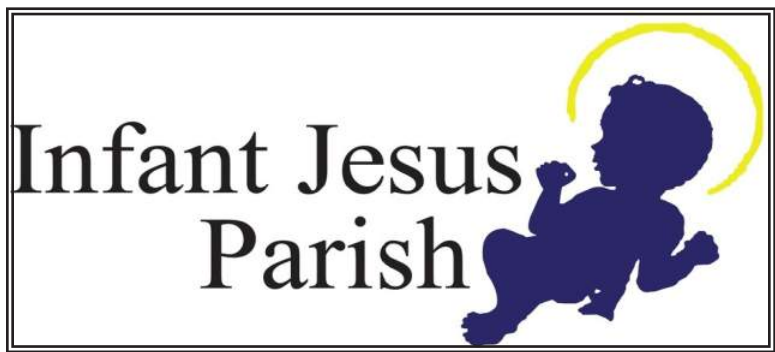

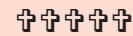

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

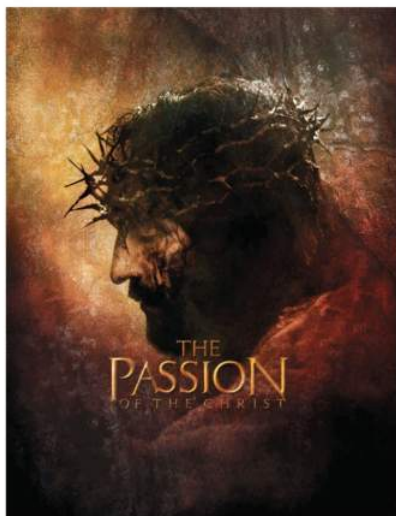
We are already halfway into the Lenten Season. Today's Gospel serves as a wakeup call for all of us: "Sir, leave it for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future. If not you can cut it down."



This parable of the "fig tree" signifies God's loving care and patient endurance. He is not quick to condemn but rather always giving us a second chance to change, to convert, and to be redeemed. Imagine if Jesus did not have patience, the entire world would be condemned and gone now.

The more we reflect upon Jesus's patient endurance, the more we find ourselves so guilty: guilty because we take His patience for granted every day, whereas we have so little patience for others if not at all. Thanks be to Jesus for His tireless patience; however, we must be conscious of the "hour" which may come to us at any time, when it comes, it would be too late to change. It is not because Jesus's patience is limited but rather because our time on this earthly journey is limited. It would never be too late if one is conscious of the need to change, to convert, to turn round, to grow, or to ask for forgiveness. If God is so patient with us and always giving us a second chance, we too need to be more patient with others. We should not be so quick to condemn even our loved ones; rather we should give others a second chance to change and grow. Remember God's mercy and forgiveness do not work with "contradiction" as we learn from the "Our Father Prayer": "Forgive us our trespasses we forgive those who trespasses against us."

Let us take this time to examine our lives to see what/where needs to be corrected, changed, or grown. Meanwhile, let us practice our charity as atonement for our sins by being more patient, loving, and forgiving. 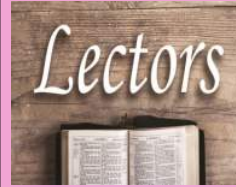

Father was born in the Philippines and came to the United States with his family as a boy. He has lived in various states and he taught high school prior to his priestly studies. After ordination, Father Caparas served as Parochial Vicar at Queen of Angels Parish in Landisville, and then at St. Peter's Parish in Merchantville. He was appointed pastor of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament in September 2011. In 2013, Father Caparas was appointed as the first Director of Catholic Identity at Gloucester Catholic High School. After serving in that position for three years, he was then appointed as the Principal and President of St. Joseph High School In Hammonton, where he served before being appointed Pastor at Mary, Mother of Mercy.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA LOVES TO VISIT



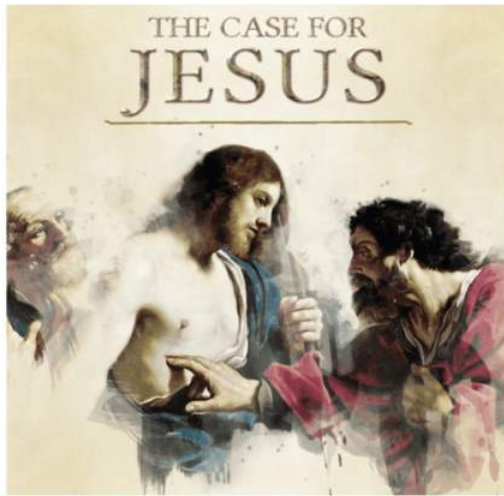

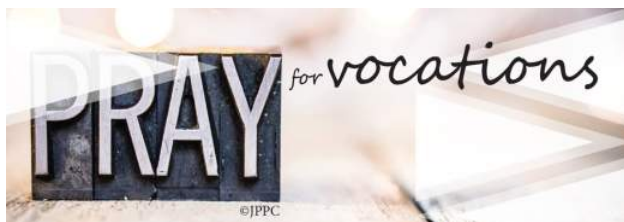
