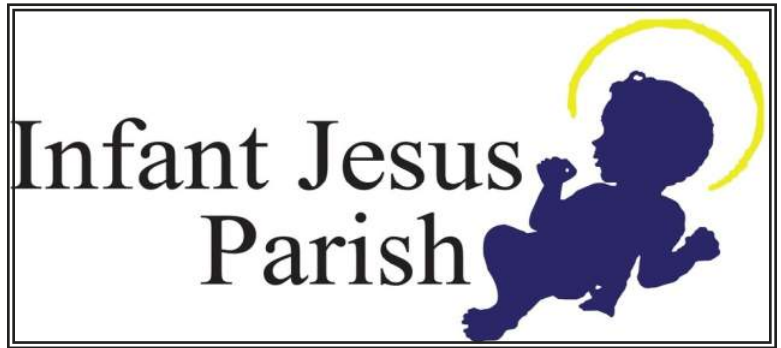




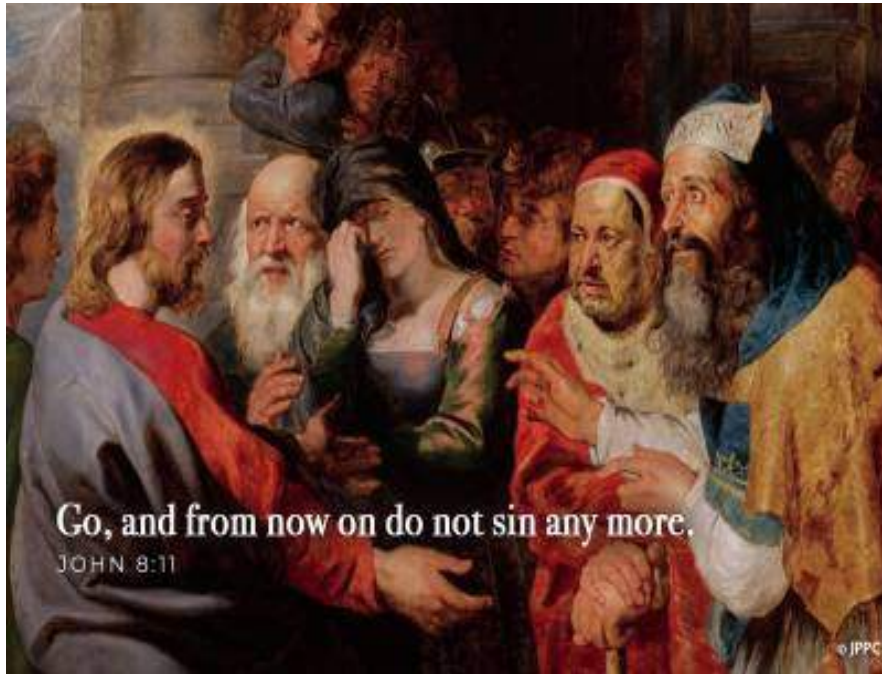

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



From the beginning, St. Paul did not believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ and zealously persecuted those who believed it. After encountering the Risen Christ, he did not just become a believer but he also considered Jesus Christ as everything in this life. As he wrote in the Second Reading today:

“I consider everything as a loss because of the supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have accepted the loss of all things and I consider them so much rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him....”

For St. Paul, to know Jesus, to have Jesus, and to live Jesus in this life is a treasure which he values the most, above and beyond everything else in this finite world. Truly St. Paul's testimonial witness of his faith in Christ was the most powerful and undeniable proof of Christ's resurrection. As believers in the Risen Christ, like St. Paul, we too should make Christ the center of our lives, we should put Christ above and beyond everything else. We should not let any works, sports, entertainment, worldly concerns or attractions prevent us from Sunday worshiping or anything that separates us from the love of God and our neighbors.

Only a week away, we will celebrate Holy Week, the commemoration of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. We are reminded that Jesus paid the price of our sins and gained us back to his heavenly kingdom. Therefore; we have a second chance to live our lives for Christ, to “gain Christ and to be found in Him”. It is indeed a “big loss” for those who do not realize that “all things are rubbish”, things are passing away, here today and gone tomorrow. It is a “waste of time” for those who focus on worldly affairs and do not have time for God even only one hour at Sunday Mass. It is unwise to “gain the whole world and forfeit one's soul” (Matt 16:26). It is too late for those who are so “blinded” to the need of Christ in this life, the Redeemer of humanity, the truths revealed by Him, and the truths of human destiny.

Amen.



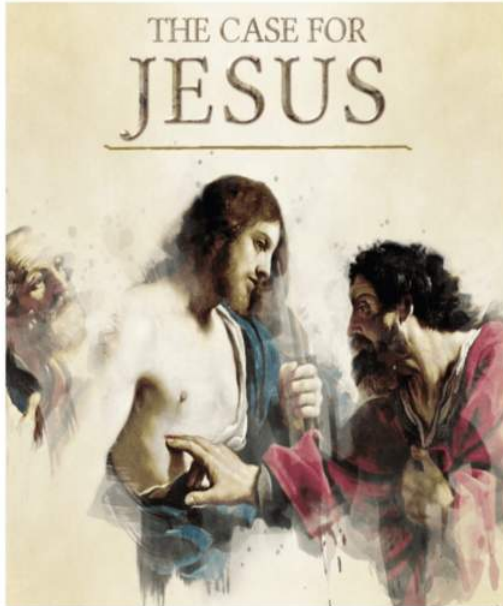

VEILING OF STATUES AND ICONS DURING PASSIONTIDE



This ancient Catholic practice stems from the former liturgical calendar in which the old Gospel reading for the 5th Sunday of Lent (i.e., the start of Passiontide) tells us on how Jesus hid Himself away from the Jews when they attempted to stone Him.

According to St. Augustine, at this moment when Jesus “hid Himself” from the Jews, Christ in fact became invisible by virtue of His Divine nature. To help signify this mystery, crucifixes and images of Christ are veiled with purple cloth on the evening before the start of the Passiontide. The same goes with the images of the saints, as it is befitting that if the glory of the Master is hidden, then His servants should not appear.

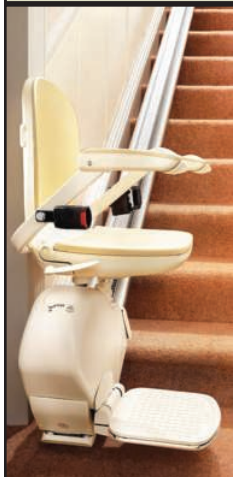
