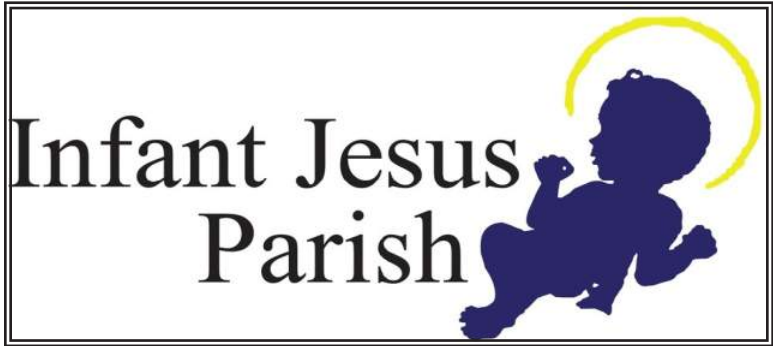




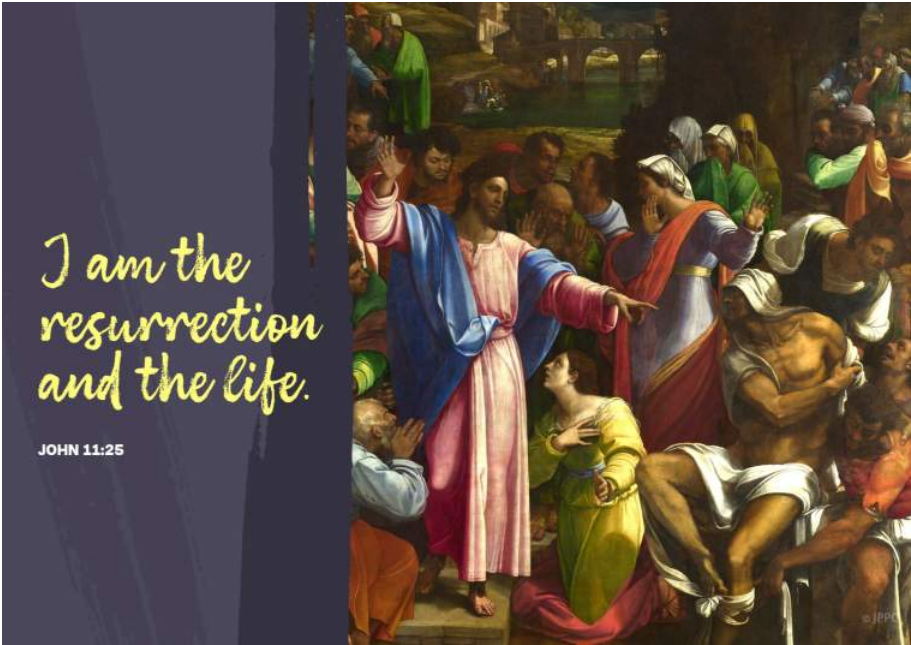

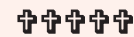

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



There are couple things in today's Gospel which should be taken to heart for reflection. This Gospel is about the story of Lazarus who was dead for four days in the tomb but was raised back to life by Jesus.

When Jesus was at the tomb, the first thing he said was: "Take away the stone". Why did he say that? He was able to raise the dead to life, he but could not move the stone himself? That is not the case. Jesus' purpose of raising Lazarus from death to life is not meant just for this "earthly life" but rather it is essentially meant for the "spiritual life". If it was meant only to raise Lazarus from his "physical death to life", then Jesus would not ask to remove the stone from the tomb; he would do it himself. However, by asking someone to remove the physical stone which closed Lazarus' tomb, Jesus is signifying the spiritual implication of the "stone." The "stone" of selfishness, hatred, resentment, or hardening of the heart which closes one's heart and mind from being receptive to God's Word and being healed, touched, restored, and transformed by his transforming power in the Sacraments.

After the stone was removed, Jesus called Lazarus by name: "Lazarus, come out!" This also has a spiritual significance which signifies the Sacrament of Baptism. At Baptism, we were called by name, "Mary or Joseph, I baptize you...", to come out the "tomb" of original sin, to be raised back to new life in Christ.

Unfortunately, due to our sins, we return and are buried in the "tomb" again after being raised from Baptism. Just like Lazarus who also later died again. However, the problem is not about being buried in the "tomb" again through sin; but rather it is about the willingness to remove the "stone". As we come to an end of Lent, are we willing to remove the "stone" which closes our hearts to Jesus' voice who is constantly calling us to "come out" of the "tomb" and be raised up to new life?

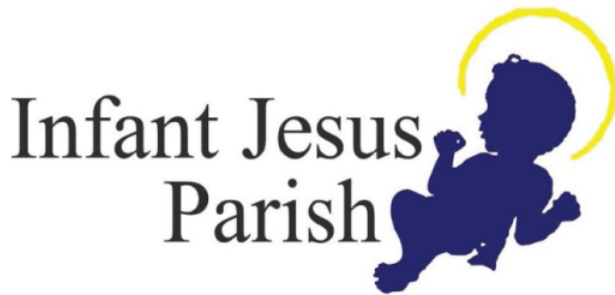

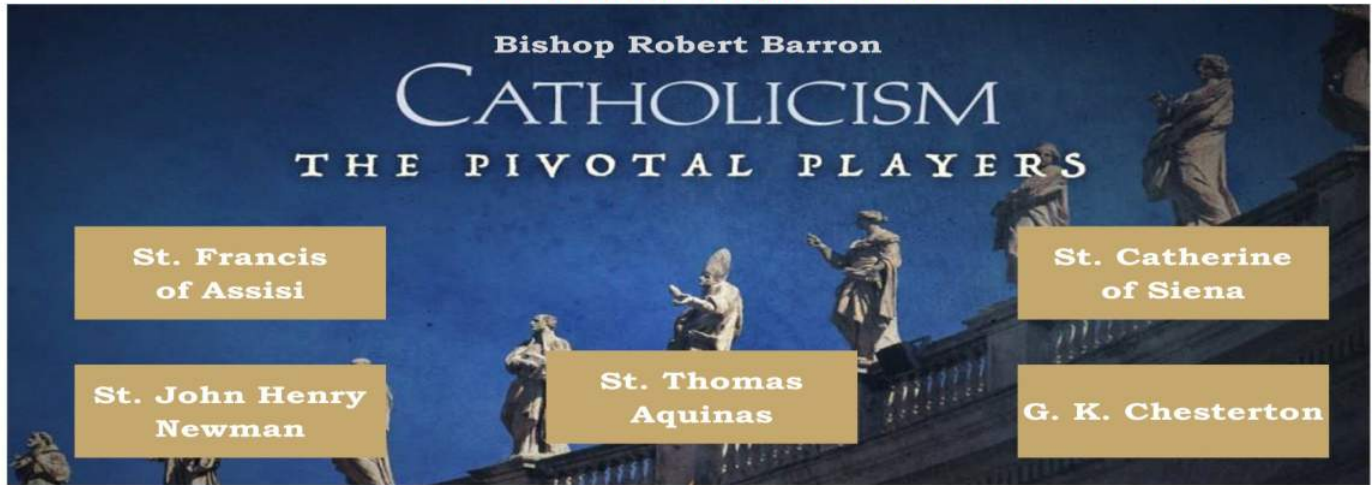
