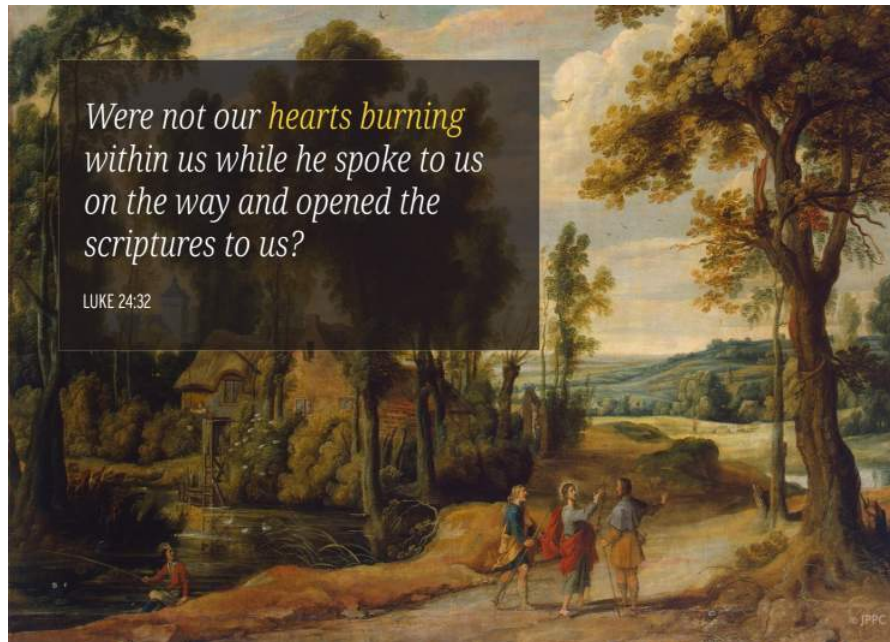

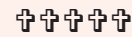

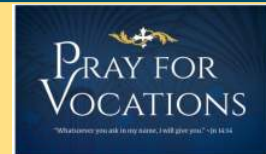

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, we will learn two essential points which serve as a "wake-up call" for our spiritual life.

First, the Gospel tells us that, after the death of Jesus Christ, two of his disciples went on a journey to Emmaus. On the road, they discussed everything that happened to Jesus in Jerusalem. They felt confused, afraid, weary, and hopeless at the death of their Master. However, Jesus did not abandon them. He accompanied them on the journey and even joined in their conversation, yet they still failed to recognize him.

Like these two disciples, our life on earth is a journey to the Kingdom of God. Along the way, we sometimes feel confused, anxious, weary, hopeless, and even losing the desire to live due to a sudden death of a loved one, a change in our job, in our relationship, or a tragic incidence that has happened in our lives or in the life of a loved one. We feel like we are walking alone on the "road". Just like the two disciples, we feel like God is not with us or accompanying us in time of difficulty.

After listening to the explanation of what happened in Jerusalem from the two disciples, Jesus became so frustrated and said: "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke!" Jesus then opened their minds with his interpretation of the Scriptures. In the same way, we need to allow Jesus to speak to us through his words in the Scriptures. We need to talk to Jesus through our reflections, meditations, and prayers, so that he will help us to understand what is going on in our lives or that of our families in the perspective of God's will and providential care.

Secondly, "While He was with them at table, He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened, and they recognized Him". Jesus chose this moment of the "breaking of the bread" to reveal himself to the two disciples.

In the same manner, whenever we gather for the "breaking of bread" on the Altar, Jesus is present in our midst. Therefore, the Eucharistic celebration is the most tangible way for us to be in touch with the Divine Jesus, to be intimately united to him on earth and a pledge of eternal life for us in heaven.
