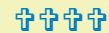

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus identifies himself as a Shepherd who "calls his sheep by name" and "walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice".

In the same way, Jesus called each one of us by name at our Baptism: "Mary/Joseph, I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". Jesus calls us by name because he created us. He knew each one of us before we were born. He created us since he wanted to share his life and love with us. Even when humanity goes astray, he does not abandon us. Rather He empties himself and becomes like us, except sin, so as to lead us and bring us back to the sheepfold. Thanks be to Jesus Christ who is our Good Shepherd, who laid down his life to bring us back to the fold. As the Good Shepherd, he is constantly searching for the lost sheep through the Sacrament of Penance. His voice is constantly calling us to follow him through his words in the Scripture, his teachings, and his Commandments.

However, in our daily live, our minds are occupied with so many "voices": "the voice of social media, the voice of greed, the voice of lust, the voice of selfishness, etc." These "voices" are so "loud" and so "strong" that they would silence the voice of the Good Shepherd in our hearts and our consciences. These "voices" deviously appeal more to our temporal needs and desire which contradict the meaning and purpose of the life that God wants us to live.

Let us listen to the "voice" of our Good Shepherd which leads us on the right path to eternal life and happiness. Let us listen to the "voice" of the Good Shepherd which leads us to eternal life and not the "voice" of the flesh which leads us to eternal damnation.
