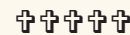

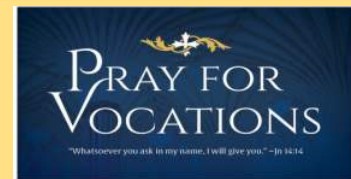


SANCTUARY LAMP
