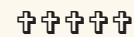

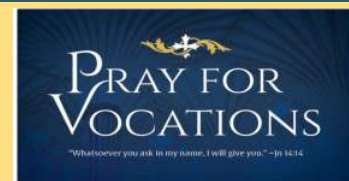


SANCTUARY LAMP

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, we joyfully celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus

Christ into heaven. Jesus ascended into heaven in order to unite all members of His Mystical Body to God, the Father. When our Lord Jesus took upon Himself our human nature, He united Himself to all of us, the members of the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ, for all eternity. In other words, after accomplishing His redemptive mission, Jesus did not “take off” His human nature before ascending to the Father; but rather the same Jesus both human and divine ascended into heaven and remains united with God, the Father.

Therefore, the ascension of Jesus is not for His sake, but fit is for ours sake, since Jesus never left the Father even when He came down on earth. We now can say that we are the members of the Mystical Body of Christ. The members of this Mystical Body are still on this earthly pilgrimage, but our Head is already in heaven. One day the Head will draw all His faithful members into heaven with Him. As the Head died, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of God the Father, we too, as members of Christ's Body, have already passed through death sacramentally by Baptism. However, still wait for the completion of our incorporation in Jesus's death through our physical death and then we too will be raised up to where our Head is.

We must thank Jesus every day for allowing us to be members of His Body in which we are able to draw strength in times of weakness, comfort in times of sorrow, healing in times of brokenness, and peace in times of despair. Remember: Our Head is in heaven and “If we have died with him, we shall also live with him; if we persevere, we shall also reign with him in heaven” said St. Paul (2 Tim 2:11-12).

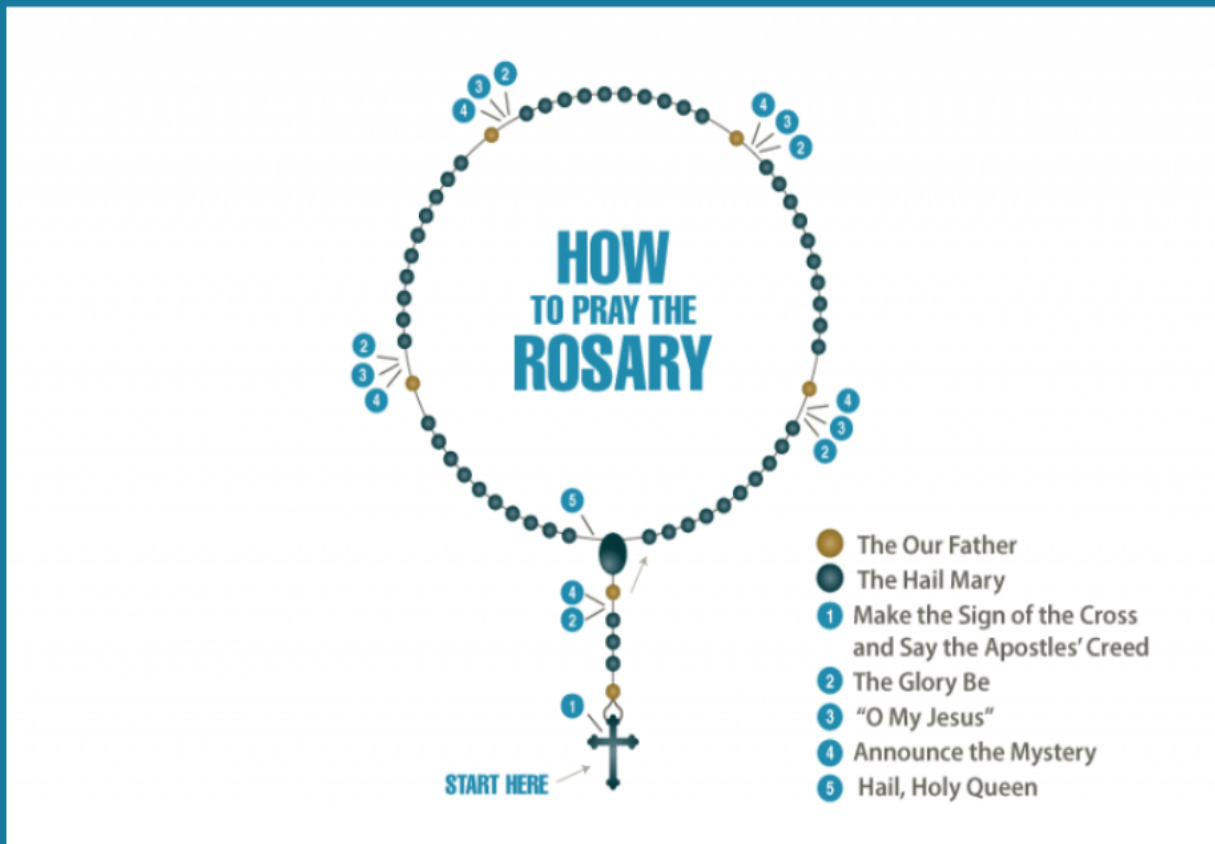
