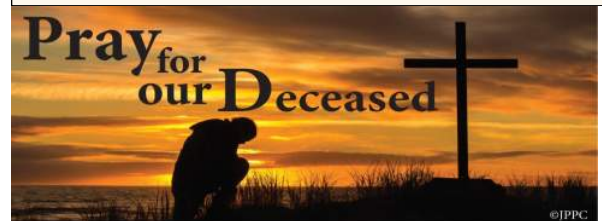

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we gather to celebrate Pentecost Sunday, it reminds us of the day that the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles and empowered them to proclaim fearlessly the Good News to all nations. The word “Pentecost” from Greek, meaning “manifestation”. On this day, the Holy Spirit manifested the Church to the whole world. On Good Friday, the Church was born from the wounded side of the crucified Jesus; but not yet fully manifested to the whole world until at the day of Pentecost.

When the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire, their fear of the Jews disappeared. They began to preach publicly about Jesus crucified in different languages so that everyone from various races and nations were able to understand. One of the main purposes of Pentecost was that the Holy Spirit enabled the Apostles to communicate the Good News of salvation to all people from different races, languages, and cultures.

As we know language is an essential means in communication. It is a bridge that connects heart to heart and mind to mind. There are so many different languages spoken in the world, and in order to understand them, we have no choice but to learn them. However, there is a language that everyone in the world is able to understand regardless of race or culture. It is a language not acquired from learning. It does not come from written form of letters, characters, or symbols, but it is from the heart, the language of love.

The problems such as violence, abuse, brokenness, hatred, or suffering in the world and in our own families today, are indeed caused by people who speak their own “selfish language”. The language that speak only to and for themselves but not to and for others.

As Easter people, the people of faith, hope, and love, let us pray that the Holy Spirit may empower us to speak the language that everyone in our families and in our world can relate to and understand: the language of Jesus-love.

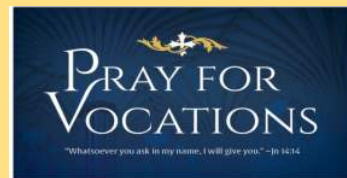
