## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the most profound and precious Gifts of our faith: the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus did not abandon us or leave us orphaned after His Ascension to the Father in heaven. Rather He was, is, and will be with us until the end of time in the form of the Eucharist.

When Jesus said: “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal” (John 6:54), He meant that whoever is united to Him, receives Him, or was in communion with Him, would have eternal life with Him in heaven. For this reason, the Church constantly reminds the faithful the importance of attending Mass regularly on Sunday. Indeed, God is everywhere. We don’t have to go to church to pray; however, we cannot be intimately united, connected, and in communion with Jesus except by participating in the sacrifice of the Eucharist, the real Body and Blood of Christ.

At the Last Supper, Jesus took the bread and wine and directly said to His disciples: “Take and eat ..., take and drink... This is my body... This is the chalice of my blood...”. By saying this Jesus meant it. He would not say it unless He meant it. Therefore, the sacrifice of the Mass is the ultimate source of salvation. During the Mass, the same sacrifice that Jesus Christ offered on Calvary over 2000 years ago is being made present again on the altar by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is done so that the faithful, from generation to generation, is able to partake in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ for their own salvation.

In other words, “the sacrifice of the Holy Mass is for those who were not there when Jesus was crucified”. We were not there when Jesus was crucified, so let us come faithfully every Sunday to be partakers of the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ, the pledge of our eternal life which is only to be found in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

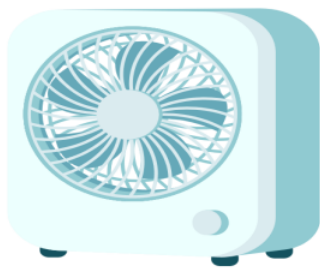

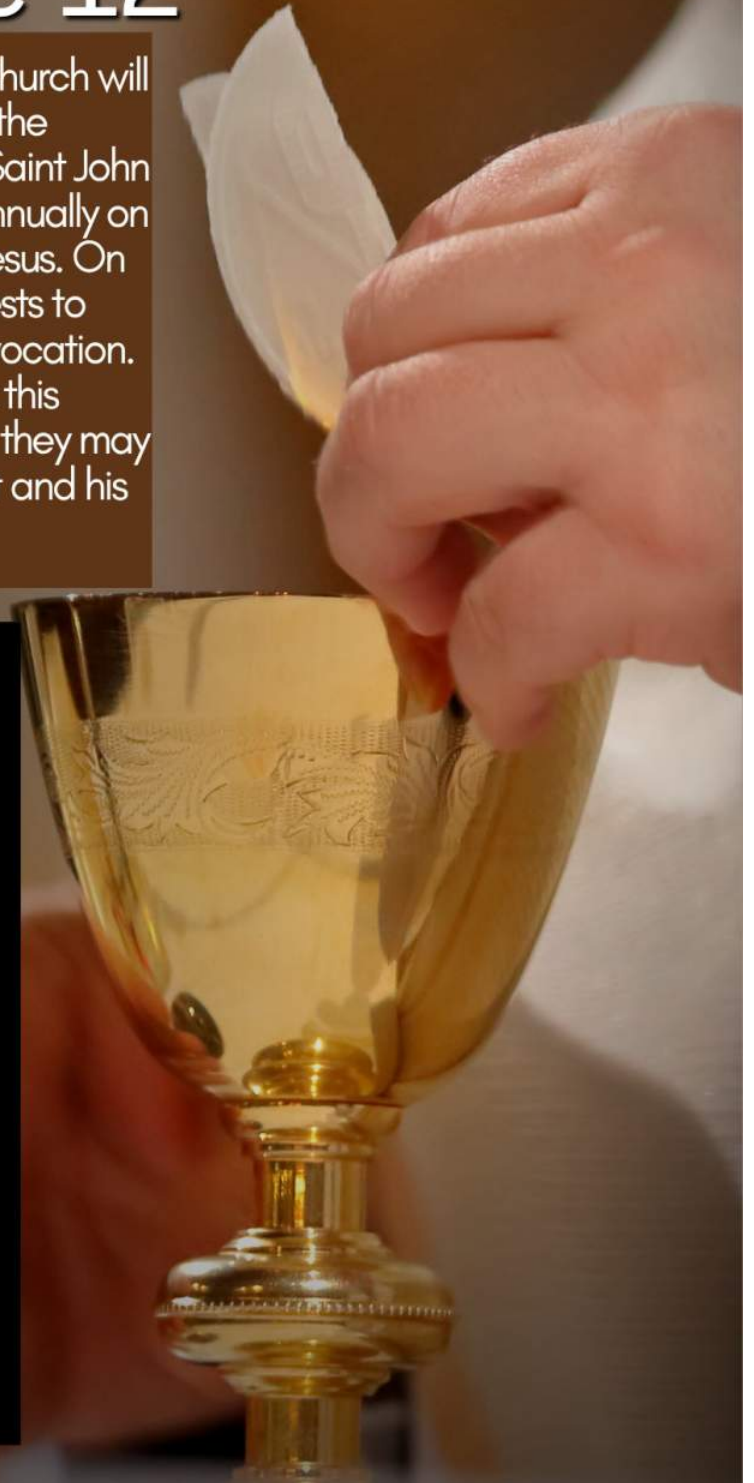
# World Day of Prayer For the Sanctification of Priests June 12<sup>th</sup>
