## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus summons the twelve disciples on the mission of healing. Their mission was to "drive out demons and cure the sick." Indeed, this same mission is also entrusted to each one of us at our Baptism and is constantly reaffirmed at the end of the Mass: "Go in peace, and glorify the Lord by your life".

Today, more than ever, "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few". Jesus truly needs our feet to go out into the "fields" to be Christ-like to others. He needs our hands to reach out to those in need of our "bread", our time, patience, forgiveness, and compassion to heal the hurt and broken. Jesus needs laborers who can bring comfort to the grieving and hope to the hopeless.

The "harvest is abundant". The needy, the despair, and the suffering are "abundant" around us, but "the laborers are few". Jesus needs us as laborers for his kingdom. He needs husbands and wives to heal each other's "hurt and brokenness" which can separate them apart. Jesus needs brothers and sisters to heal the "disputes" among them due to disagreement, differences, or selfishness.

Let us find ways to heal one another first before we talk about Jesus, live Jesus, or worship Jesus. Let each one of us strive to fulfill our divine mission entrusted to us because: "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give". And ultimately we can rejoice "because your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10: 20).

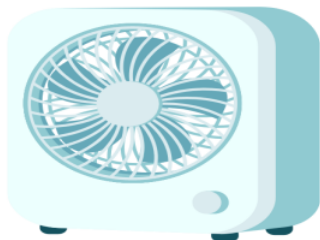
