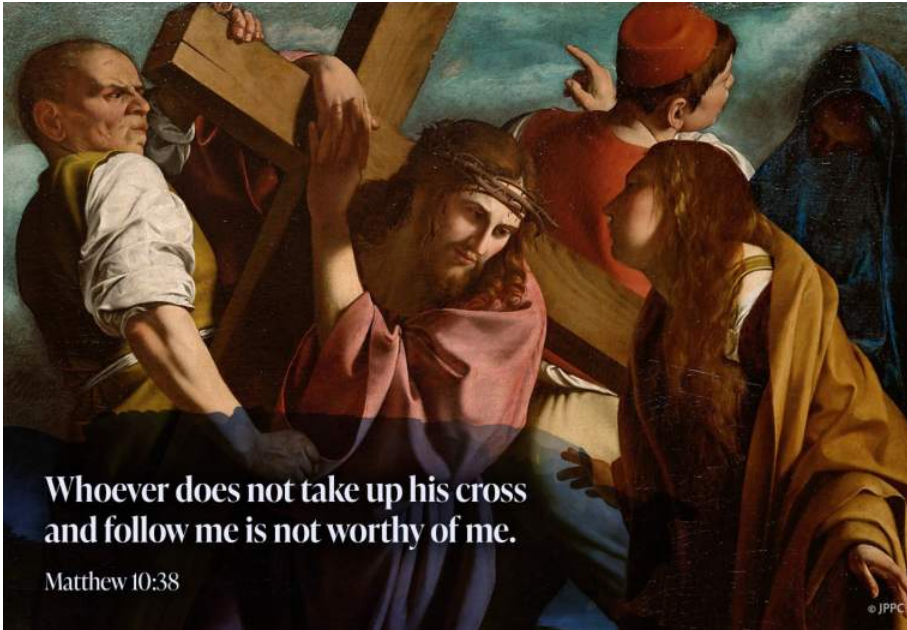

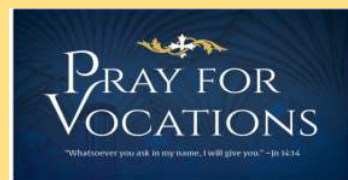

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges us to love him above and beyond everything in this life, even our loved ones. Why did Jesus say that? 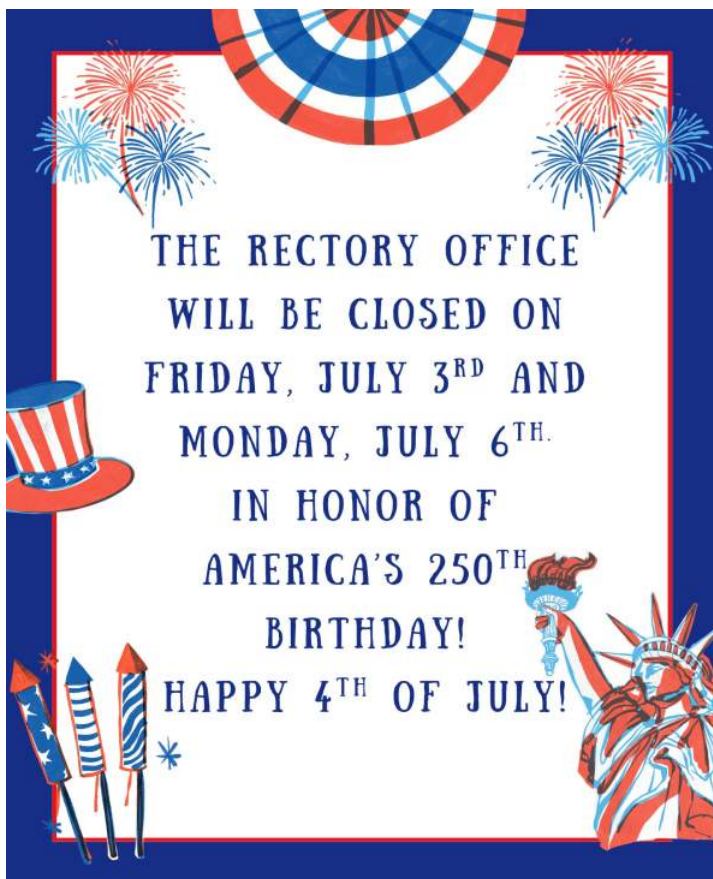

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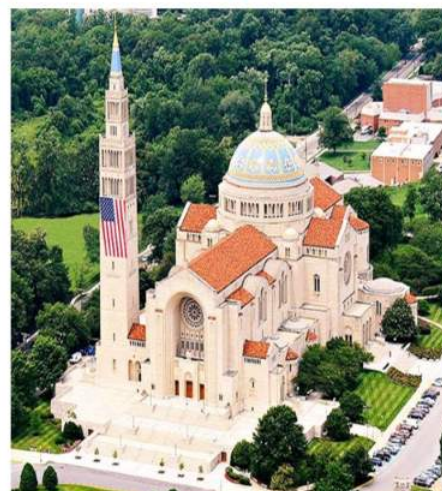

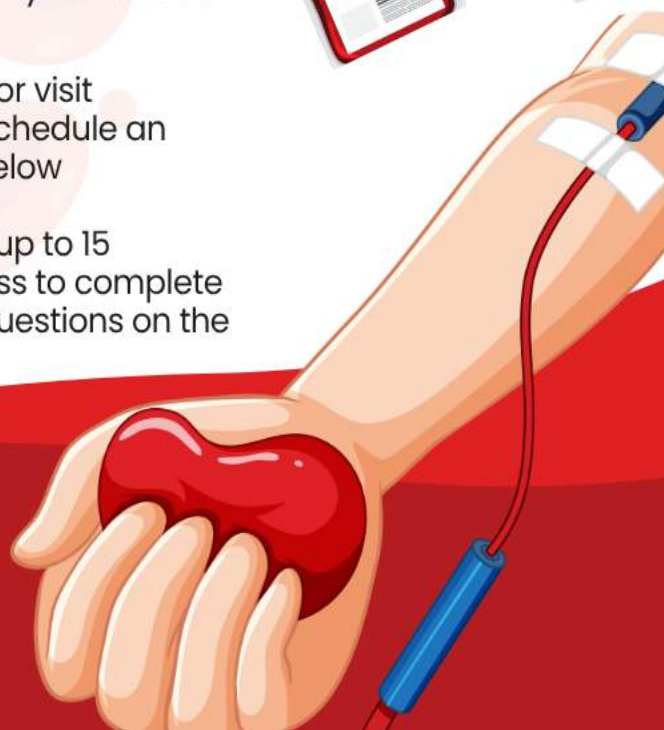
