FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Second Reading, St. Paul wrote: "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us." (Romans 8:18).

St. Paul did not say this just for the sake of saying it; but rather he himself was willing to accept all the sufferings that came into his life for the sake of the truths taught by Jesus Christ. Encouraged and inspired by St. Paul's words and his good example of faith in Christ, we should not be afraid of embracing the sufferings in this earthly life. We, of course, don't like suffering. However, it is unavoidable because this life is not perfect. Everything can go astray at anytime. We should rather suffer physically, mentally or morally for the love of God and our neighbor and for the sake of Christ's teachings than betray God's love or give up our faith in Christ.

Some people stop practicing their faith when facing the suffering of illness, betrayal, the loss of a loved one, or the sins of others. What we need to know is that whatever the suffering is, it will not last ever. Someday it will be gone, however, the glory to be revealed in heaven for those who are faithful to the end is beyond words could describe. After all, what matters is the reward of eternal life and happiness in the glory of heaven.

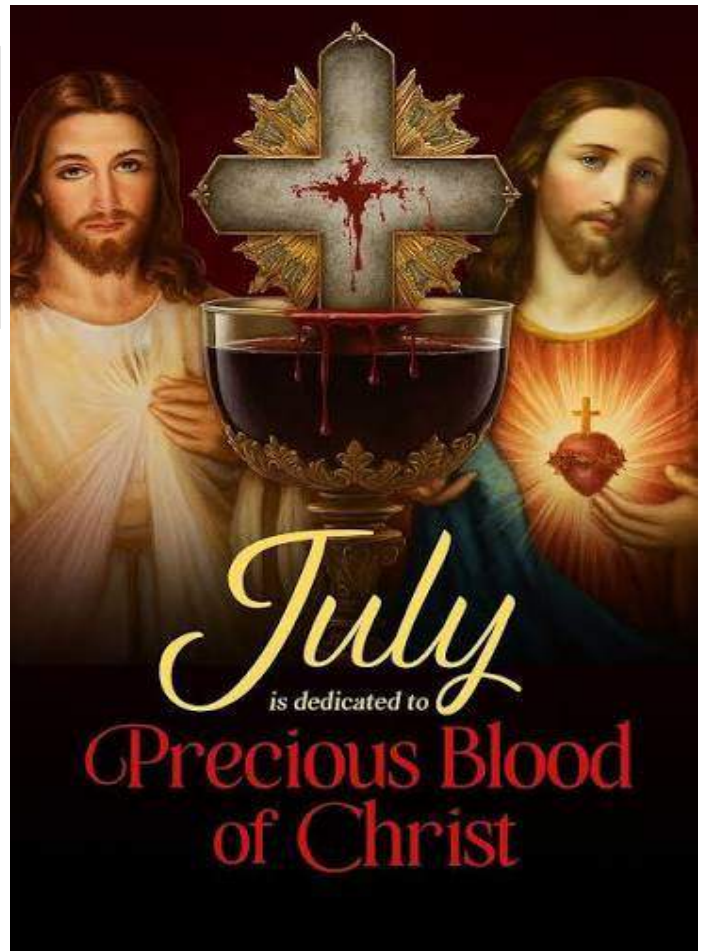

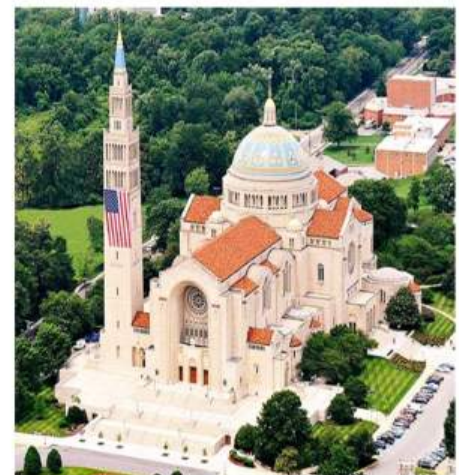
