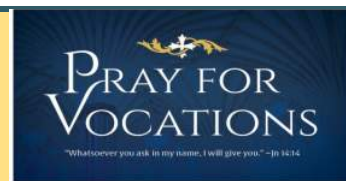

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus spoke in parables to describe the kingdom of heaven. He used parables because the kingdom of heaven is not a "place" here or there; but rather it is a "state of being". When Jesus entered the world, he brought with him the kingdom of God. Therefore the kingdom of God is "already here but not yet". It will not yet come to its "fullness" until the end of time. When Jesus comes the second time, he will bring the kingdom of heaven to its completion.

At first, Jesus shared the parable of the "Wheat and the Weeds" to describe his mercy and patient endurance toward sinners (the weeds): "His slave said to him, do you want us to go and pull them up? He replied: No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest". Jesus always gives us a second chance to change, to turn around. He is slow to condemn but quick in showing mercy. He hates sin but loves sinners. Thus; the kingdom of heaven is the kingdom of mercy and forgiveness.

Following the parable of the "Wheat and the Weeds", Jesus spoke of two more parables to imply another aspect of the kingdom of heaven: "The parables of the mustard seed and the yeast". These two parables signify the "seed or the yeast" of faith was planted within us at our Baptism. In other words, the kingdom of heaven is within us, and it needs to be "nurtured and grown". It is "already here but not yet". It is a process of "becoming" and finally "actualized" in our daily lives. Therefore, the kingdom of heaven is not a "place" to enter but rather it is a "mission" to accomplish. It is not in God's "hands" but in our "hands".

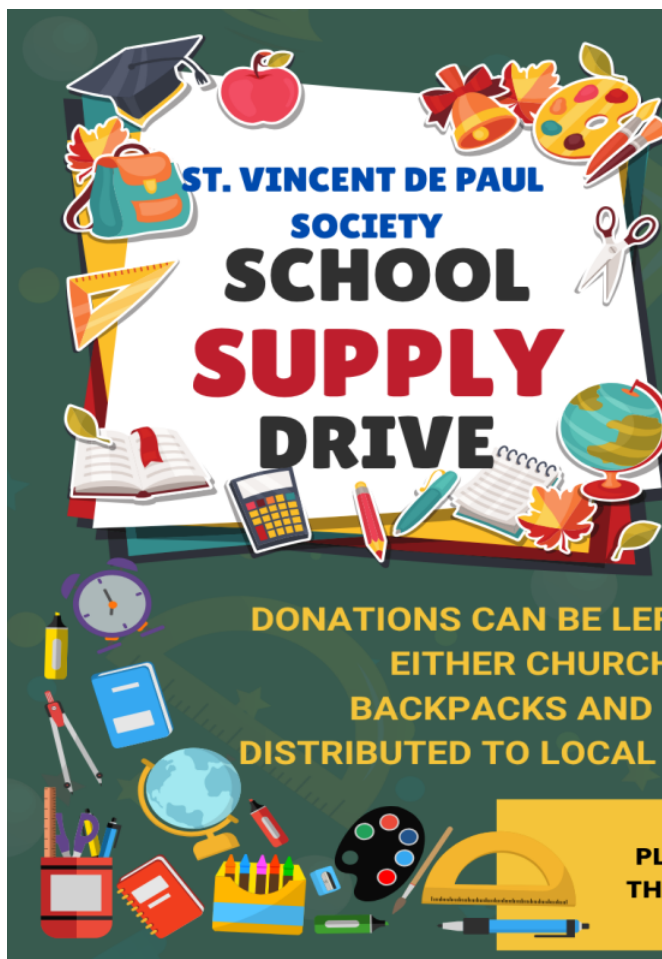
