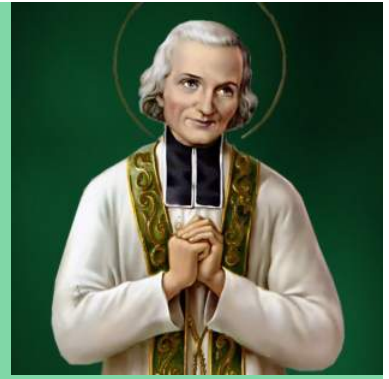
PRAY FOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Tuesday August 4, we will celebrate the Feast of St. John Vianney, one of the patron Saints of our parish. St. John Vianney was born on May 8, 1786 in Dardilly, France. The life of St. John Vianney is a powerful witness to God's unconditional love and infinite mercy. He spent hours a day in the confessional to counsel the lost, to forgive sinners and to bring them back to the truth which ultimately would save their souls.

His personal holiness, his zeal for conversion of sinners, and his love for the broken moved the hearts of many who eventually came back to the Church.
