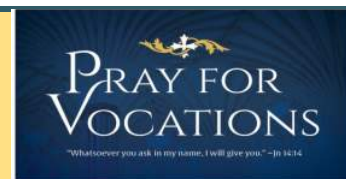

From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel is preceded by the Gospel of the miracle of the multiplication of the bread and the fish: "After he fed the people, Jesus made the disciples get into a boat and precede him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd." After witnessing the miracle of the bread, Jesus wanted to test his disciples' faith by sending them on a boat while he himself went up on the mountain to pray. When the storm came and the boat was tossed by the waves and the wind, the disciples grew terrified and began to panic. Suddenly, Jesus appeared and walked on the water toward them. However, they thought it was a ghost; but Jesus affirmed them "take courage, it is I; do not be afraid". Peter spoke up: "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water". While Peter was walking on the water, he saw how strong the wind was and he became frightened. He then began to sink and cried out, "Lord save me!"

Peter's brief success shows that faith could move mountains, but doubt could cause failure. He began sinking because he turned his eyes away from Jesus. He focused on the strong wind and big waves instead of fixing his eyes upon Jesus alone.

This Gospel serves as a "wakeup" lesson for our spiritual life. Like the disciples, it is easy for us to forget the miraculous and good things that God has done for us in the past when facing "strong wind and big waves" in our lives. Since we live in an unpredicted and imperfect world, our life is like a "boat" which is constantly being tossed by "strong winds and big waves" of adversities and worldly allurements. In order to avoid "sinking", we must fix our eyes upon Jesus always. With our eyes anchored on Jesus, we will be able to do the "impossible" just like Peter did at first, when he was able to walk on water.
