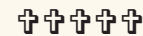

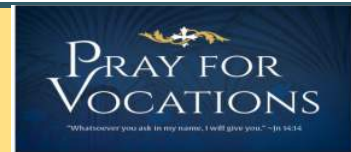

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

What a humble and righteous prayer the Canaanite woman prayed in today's Gospel: "Have pity on me, Lord Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon". First of all, as Canaanite woman, she knew who she was, a pagan who did not belong to the "group" of God's chosen people. Therefore, she recognized her unworthiness when asking any favors from Jesus. Secondly, she passed the "test" of true humility given by Jesus: "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs". She replied: "Please Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their master".

Very often, when praying, it is easy for us to forget who we really are in the presence of God. We lack the righteous disposition which is being conscious of our unworthiness. We must keep in mind that we do not deserve to raise our hands and ask God for anything since, from the beginning when sin entered into the world, the whole human race was condemned to eternal death. Therefore, like the Canaanite woman, all we should ask for is "Lord have pity or mercy on me". A common unrighteous disposition in prayer is: "I have been faithfully worshipping you Lord, so now it's your "turn" and you should listen and respond to my prayer". Remember that, for whatever we do for God or for others through charity, these still can not "pay" for our salvation except the out-pouring of blood of the Lamb.

In the mean time, if our prayers are not answered or the answer is not what we wanted, we begin to lose patience, even question his providential care, and consequently turn away from him. We must learn a lesson of true humility from the Canaanite woman, remember that, when she was rejected and humiliated by Jesus, she did not lose her patience. She did not get upset or turn away. Rather she was more patient and more persistent in begging and finally won Jesus's heart. Remember only righteous disposition and true humility will move Jesus's heart.

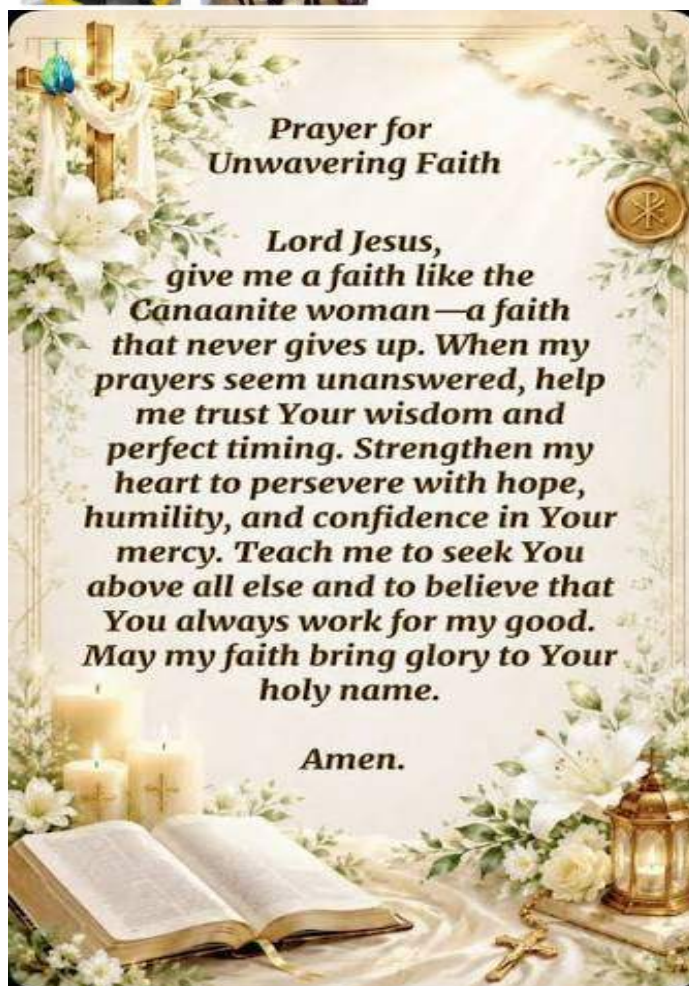

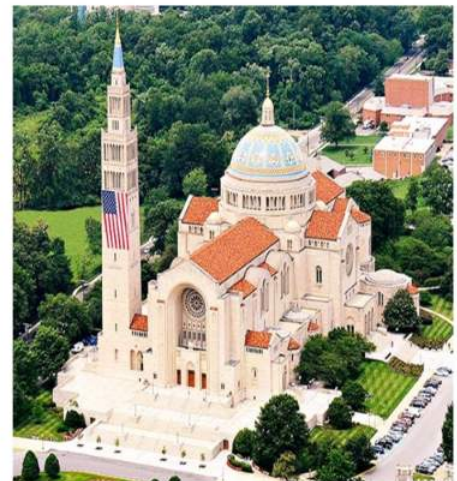
