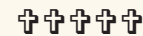

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” asked Jesus in today’s Gospel. When Jesus asked his disciples this question, they replied: “Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah, or one of the prophets”. Surprisingly, Jesus did not seem to be interested or cared so much about what others said about him; rather he emphasized: “But who do you say that I am?” Then Peter quickly responded: “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God”.

The disciples had followed Jesus for years. They heard Jesus’s teaching by their own ears. They saw Jesus performing miraculous deeds by their own eyes. They ate at the same table with Jesus. Therefore, Jesus wanted to know what and how much did they truly know about him.

Today Jesus would ask each one of us the same question: “Who you do say that I am?” Like St. Peter’s answer, Jesus expects a personal response from our hearts. Do we know Jesus only through learning from Catholic school or Religious Education and so knowing him as an “informational” Jesus? Or do we know Jesus only by going to church, receiving the Sacraments and so knowing him as a “religious” Jesus? If we only know the “informational” Jesus or “religious” Jesus, we are “building” our faith-foundation on “sands”.

Jesus has done so much for us personally. Each day he is involved in every “part” of our being since without him there is nothing coming into existence. Without him nothing is good. Therefore, we should know him not through information or religious practice but rather through his active divine presence in our lives. If we take time to discern and reflect, we will recognize Jesus’ loving care in our relationships with our loved ones. We will recognize him in our “daily bread” at our dinner tables. We will recognize his protective care in everything which is going on in our lives and our families. Only knowing Jesus in this way will our “house” not be ruined or collapse when “storm, wind, or flood” comes.

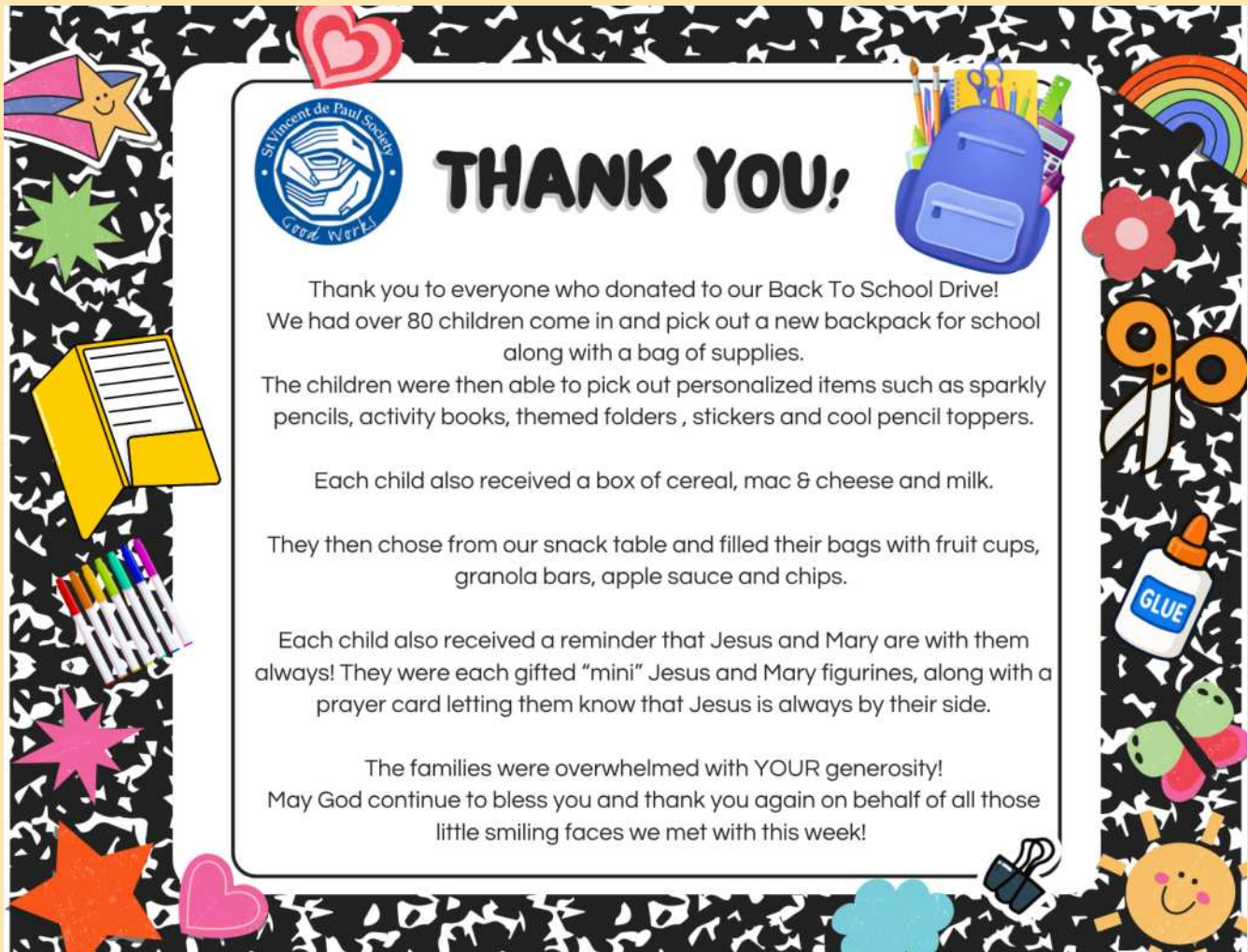
HEALING MASS

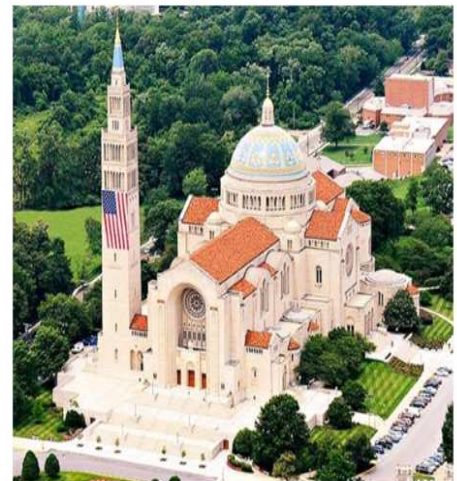

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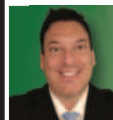
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
