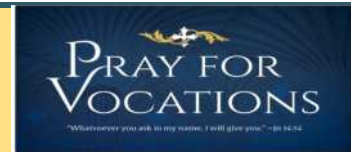

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are living in a world in which the future is unknown and everything is uncertain. Regardless of believers or non-believers, anything can go wrong at any moment even if we try to do the best we can to prevent it. Our Lord Jesus was aware of this uncertainty in our lives; therefore, he said in today's Gospel: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me".

Jesus himself did not like the cross at all; but he accepted it because of the Father's will and also for the good of our salvation. In the same way, none of us like to carry any cross in our lives. However, if it is God's will, we should accept it, carry it and follow Jesus' footsteps. If we are willing to accept our crosses for Christ's sake, we will not lose anything but rather gain everything: "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it".

We do not look for a cross but if it comes into our lives, we must be willing to accept it. We cannot live our lives in the ocean of fear or worry. We must learn to put our total trust and faith in God's divine providence and surrender our unknown future into his almighty hands. During our time on earth, we need to turn to Jesus as our ultimate divine protector, director, healer, and comforter. He is the only one who can usher us safely on our earthly journey to our heavenly kingdom in this unstable world. Let us join our crosses to Jesus' cross and offer it to God, the Father, as a redemptive sacrifice for our own sins and the sins of others. In this way, our suffering will not be wasted.

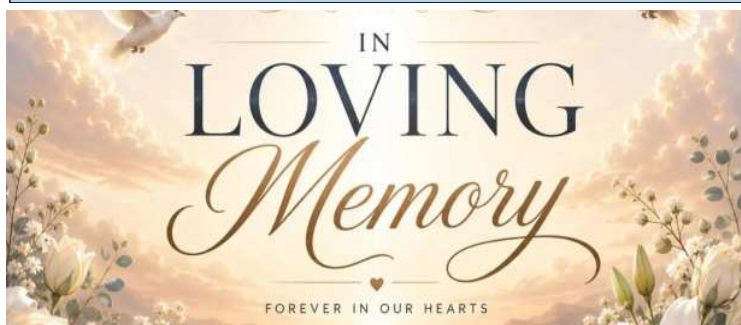

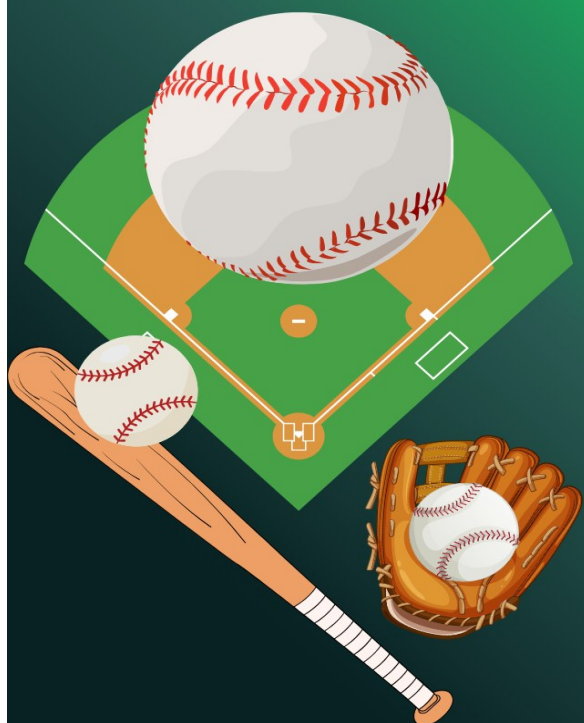

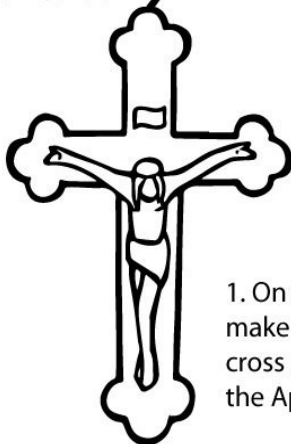

The Holy Rosary For Kids



1. On the crucifix, make the sign of the cross and then pray the Apostles' Creed.

2. On the first large bead, pray the Our Father.

3. Pray the Hail Mary on the following three small beads.

5. On the large bead, meditate on the first mystery and pray the Our Father.

4. On the chain before the next bead, pray the Glory Be.

6. Pray a Hail Mary on each of the 10 smaller beads.

7. On the chain before the next decade, pray the Glory Be & The Fatima Prayer.

8. Repeat each decade (steps 5, 6 & 7) starting with the Our Father until you reach the medal in the center.

9. Finish by praying the Hail, Holy Queen and closing prayer.

1 Make the Sign of the Cross and then reciting the Apostles' Creed

THE CREED: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate; was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty. He shall come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

2 Recite the Our Father.

THE OUR FATHER: Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

3 Recite three Hail Marys.

HAIL MARY: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

4 Recite the Glory Be.

GLORY BE to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

5 Announce the first mystery and recite the Our Father.

6 Recite ten Hail Marys.

7 Recite the Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer.

FATIMA PRAYER: Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy. Amen.

8 Announce the second mystery. Recite the Our Father and repeat the steps through the rosary.

9 Once you've completed the mysteries, Recite the Hail Holy Queen and end with the Sign of the Cross.

Hail Holy Queen: Hail, Holy Queen, mother of mercy; our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us. And after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen.
