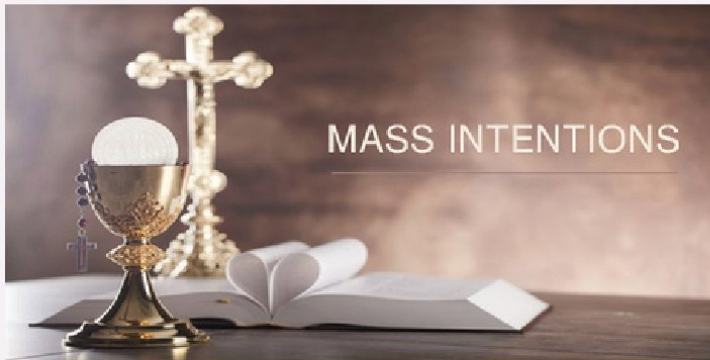

## Pastor's Corner



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As our nation observes Labor Day this weekend, we, as Christians, should celebrate it not just as a civil event but also with religious significance. From the beginning of creation, God created a perfect world which was free of human suffering, natural disaster, and death. However, human beings misused the God-given power of free will therefore sin entered the world, and human labor was one of the consequences of this original sin:

“Because of what you have done, the ground will be under a curse. You will have to work hard all your life to make it produce enough food for you”. (Gen 3:17).

However, thanks be to God for his unconditional love and infinite mercy. He sent his only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem humanity and to reconcile all creation to himself. By this virtuous act of redemption of his Son, God transformed the “curse” of human labor into a “blessing”.

For this reason, our labor now has a redemptive meaning. It means our daily labor is a pro-recreation with God, making this fallen world a better place everyday. Jesus Christ's work in the economy of salvation is both human and divine. His redemptive work was human since it was involved in his human sacrifice and, at the same time, was divine because it was involved in the salvation of souls. By his redemptive work, Jesus also gave to our human labor a twofold meaning: human and divine. Working in order to support our human needs and also to “co-remake” God's creation for the better.

Let us thank God for allowing us to be part of his “re-creation”. We thank God for the success of the work of our hands. Ultimately, let us thank God for transforming the “curse” of human labor into a “blessing”, a redemptive means of human salvation.

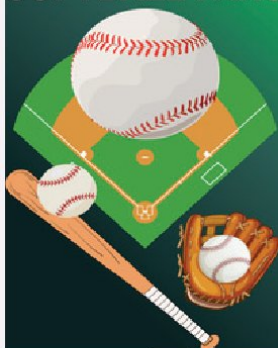
